An Act to continue several Laws relating to the further Support and Encouragement of the Fisheries carried on in the *Greenland Seas* and *Davis's Streights*, until the Twenty-fifth Day of *December* One thousand eight hundred, and to the discontinuing the Duties payable on the Importation of Tallow, Hog's Lard, and Grease, until the Twenty-fifth Day of *March* One thousand eight hundred and six. [12th July 1799.]

WHEREAS the Laws herein-after mentioned have been found Preamble.
useful and beneficial, and are near expiring; be it therefore enacted by the King's most Excellent Majesty, by and with the Advice and Consent of the Lords Spiritual and Temporal, and Commons, in this present Parliament assembled, and by the Authority of the same, That an Act, made in the Twenty-sixth Year of the Reign of His present Majesty, intituled, *An Act for the further Support and Encouragement of the Fisheries carried on in the Greenland Seas and Davis's Streights*, which was to be in force for Five Years, from the Twenty-fifth Day of *December* One thousand seven hundred and eighty-six; and also so much of an Act, made in the Twenty-ninth Year of the Reign of His present Majesty, intituled, *An Act for further encouraging and regulating the Newfoundland, Greenland, and Southern Whale Fisheries*, as relates to the Fisheries carried on in the *Greenland Seas* and *Davis's Streights*; which, 26 Geo. III, Cap. 41, and so much of 29 Geo. III, Cap. 53, as relates to the Fisheries carried on in the Greenland Seas and Davis's Streights, continued till Dec. 25, 1800.

by an Act made in the Thirty-second Year of the Reign of His present Majesty, were amended and continued until the Twenty-fifth Day of *December* One thousand seven hundred and ninety-eight; and which were, by another Act made in the Thirty-eighth Year of the Reign of His present Majesty, further continued until the Twenty-fifth Day of *December* One thousand seven hundred and ninety-nine, shall be, and the same is hereby further continued until the Twenty-fifth Day of *December* One thousand eight hundred.

And be it further enacted, That an Act, made in the Seventh Year of the Reign of His present Majesty, intituled, *An Act to discontinue, for a limited Time, the Duties payable upon the Importation of Tallow, Hogs Lard, and Grease*, which was to be in force for Three Years, from the Twenty-fifth Day of *March* One thousand seven hundred and sixty-seven, and from thence to the End of the then next Session of Parliament; and which by several subsequent Acts of the Tenth, Thirteenth, Sixteenth, Nineteenth, Twenty-second, Twenty-sixth, Twenty-ninth, Thirty-second, and Thirty-fifth Years of the Reign of His said Majesty, was further continued from the Expiration thereof until the Twenty-fifth Day of *March* One thousand seven hundred and ninety-nine, and from thence to the End of the then next Session of Parliament, shall be, and the same is hereby further continued until the Twenty-fifth Day of *March* One thousand eight hundred and six.
