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


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PREFACE.

To mark the occasion of the Twenty-fifth Anniversary of my Ordination, a number of my friends, members of St. Augustine's and of other congregations, have made it possible for me to publish this collection of my Church compositions. It is an interesting and happy reminder to me, of a long connection with a branch of Church work in which I have always been deeply interested.

The directions which I have given for the performance of the different numbers may be varied at the discretion of the choirmaster. Parts marked to be sung in harmony, may be sang in unison; parts marked to be sung by one section of the choir, may be sang by any other section, or may be sung by the full choir. Parts marked for trebles, may be sang by trebles and altos in unison.

When there is a high note in the treble part, a lower note is also provided.
