NEWFOUNDLAND Notice to Mariners (No. 3, of 1915) JEANSHEAD, TRINITY BAY LIGHT ESTABLISHED

Published by Authority Under the provisions of Section 6 of the War Measures Act, 1914, His Excellency the Governor in Council has been pleased to approve the following Rules and Regulations:

with respect to the plans of any such force or ships or with respect to any works of measure undertaken for or connected with the fortifications for defense of any place...

3. No person shall, without permission of the competent naval or military authority, make any photograph, sketch, plan, model or other representation of any of the forces or ships of His Majesty or of His Majesty's Allies...

4. Any person who attempts to commit, or procures, aids or abets, the commission of any act prohibited by the foregoing special regulations, or harbours any person whom he knows, or has reasonable grounds for supposing, to have acted in contravention of such regulations...

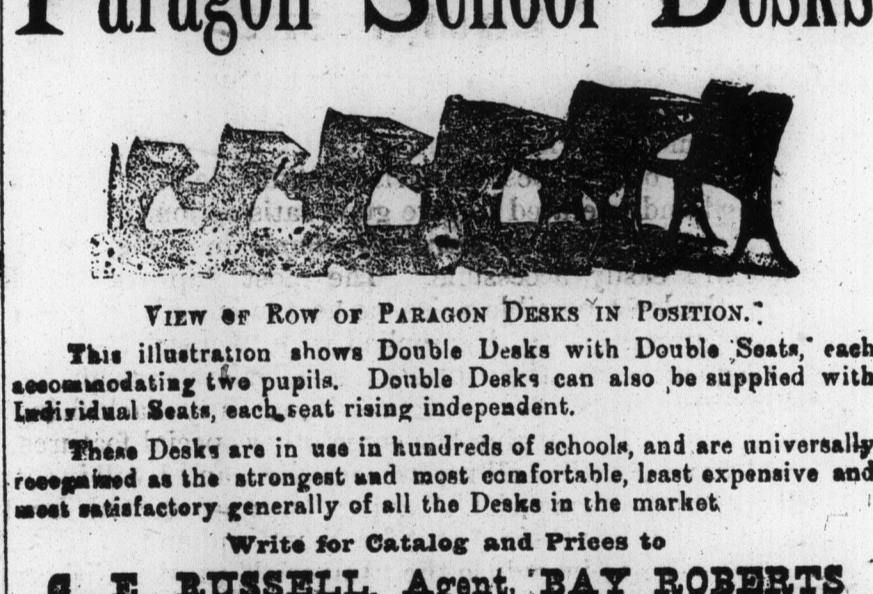

30,000 Bulgars Repulsed by French at Corna River. Salonika, Nov. 17.—General Sarail, Commander-in-Chief of the French army in the Balkans, has announced the result of a 36-hour battle at Corna River, in Southern Serbia. He declares that thirty thousand Bulgarians were repulsed along the whole line with very heavy casualties, and that not one French gun was lost. Austro-German effort to envelope Serbian armies north, it is also announced, has failed. A Serbian counter-offensive is proceeding successfully.

WAR NEWS

The Governor, Newfoundland: London, Nov. 16.—France: In Artois, after a further attack in the Labyrinth, the enemy left over 200 dead. Artillery sections in Soissons and Argonne have become more sustained.

Russia: The enemy have been further repulsed on the Bzura front but have made some progress in the region of the River Styr. During the past month the Russians have captured 50,000 prisoners, 21 guns and 118 machine guns.

Italy: Further progress in the Corso Plateau; about 300 prisoners captured. Serbia: Enemy reports claim capture of 7,500 prisoners and 12 guns.
