THE NIAGARA HARVESTED

The Niagara Falls Paper Co.'s Turbines Successfully Tested.

NIAGARA FALLS, N.Y., Jan. 26.—Yesterday for the first time water of the upper Niagara River was admitted to the wheel pit of the Niagara Falls Paper Company...

All three turbines were run with equal smoothness and not a hitch of any kind occurred.

It is expected shortly that the company will place three more turbines in the pit of the mill which will give it 6000 horse power.

The first turbine was started at 11 o'clock. It ran smoothly and without any difficulty.

At 1 o'clock a second one was started and at 2 o'clock the third, all three running with equal smoothness.

This fact surprised those present to no small degree, considering that the machinery and wheels are of an entirely new design and the whole the most massive construction of the kind yet in operation.

The construction of the power-house, pits and feeder for this papermill was started at about the same time the big pits of the Cataract Construction Company were begun.

The pits of the papermill is 20 by 40 feet and 188 feet in depth and the water has a head of 155 feet.

It has taken nearly two years and has cost several lives, many thousands of dollars and has employed hundreds of men and horses.
