

NO LICENSE REDUCTION LOOKS LIKE SALARY GRAB

By 18 to 2 Proposal is Voted Down - Grocers' Guild Trial Begins.

Hamilton, Feb. 12.—(Special)—By 18 to 2, this evening, the city council decided to reduce the number of liquor licenses from 51 to 35. Only Aldermen Martin and Main voted for the reduction.
