An Act respecting the Dominion Oil Pipe Line and Manufacturing Company.

WHEREAS the Dominion Oil Pipe Line and Manufacturing Company has, by its petition, prayed that it be enacted as hereinafter set forth, and it is expedient to grant the prayer of the said petition : Therefore Her Majesty, by and with the 5 advice and consent of the Senate and House of Commons of Canada, enacts as follows :—

1. Section 2 of chapter 122 of the statutes of 1887 is hereby repealed, and the following is substituted therefor :—

“2. The said company, hereinafter called “the Company,” 10 may,
 (a.) lay down at a suitable depth for protection, beneath the general surface of the ground, connected and continuous pipes in such sections as seem expedient, as near as may be and as the surface of the country reasonably admits of, in a straight 15 line, or by deviations therefrom as circumstances make expedient, between the points of production, manufacture or distillation and the railway lines and navigable waters of Canada, and to such other points as the Company may wish to carry the same for the purpose of delivery and distribution to 20 the consumers thereof, as to the Company seems fit, for the purpose of carrying through the said pipes the crude oil, distillate or refined oils, or by-products of petroleum, their products and by-products, together with the products and by-products of coal or any combination of coal and oil, their pro- 25 ducts and by-products, from the places of production to the works and delivering stations of the Company, and from the works and delivering stations of the Company to all places where the Company may wish to deliver or distribute the same to the consumers thereof, and to points at or near the said 30 waters and railway lines ;

(b.) lay down such branches or subsidiary pipes diverging 35 from any of the points aforesaid as are deemed expedient for connecting at the place of production or manufacture the said crude oil, distillate or refined oils, or by-products of petroleum and the products and by-products of coal or any combination of coal and oil, their products and by-products, and for deliver- 40 ing the same to the consumers thereof and to vessels on the said waters or to the said railways, for conveying or delivering the same to such company or person as the Company desires

(c.) produce, refine, store, transport, convey, sell and deal in 45 petroleum and its products and by-products, and the products and by-products of coal or any combination of coal and oil, their products and by-products ;

(d.) produce, manufacture, mine, refine, store and convey any of the ores of iron, gold, silver, copper, or other metals or

- metalloids or any products or by-products thereof, and manufacture the same for use in any form whatsoever ;
- Tanks, etc. (e.) erect, maintain and operate all such tanks, reservoirs, engines, machinery, houses and erections as are necessary or expedient for the business of the Company." 5
- Section 14 amended. 2. Section 14 of the said Act is hereby repealed, and the following is substituted therefor:—
- Capital stock. "14. The capital stock of the Company shall be five hundred thousand dollars, divided into five thousand shares of one hundred dollars each." 10
- Section 15 amended. Provisional directors. 3. Section 15 of the said Act is hereby amended by striking out the names "Thurstan G. Hall, Robert Laird, Albert R. Wilbur," and substituting therefor the names "Truman M. Hall, James W. Chisholm, Loftus E. Dancey, James R. Chisholm." 15
- Section 16 amended. Head office. 4. Section 16 of the said Act is hereby repealed, and the following is substituted therefor:—
- "16. The head office of the Company shall be in the city of Toronto, in the county of York, or in such other place in Canada as may, from time to time, be fixed by by-law." 20
- Section 25 repealed. Time for commencing pipe lines extended. 5. Section 25 of the said Act is hereby repealed, and in lieu thereof it is hereby enacted that the pipe lines authorized by the Act incorporating the Company may be commenced at any time within two years after the passing of this Act. 25
