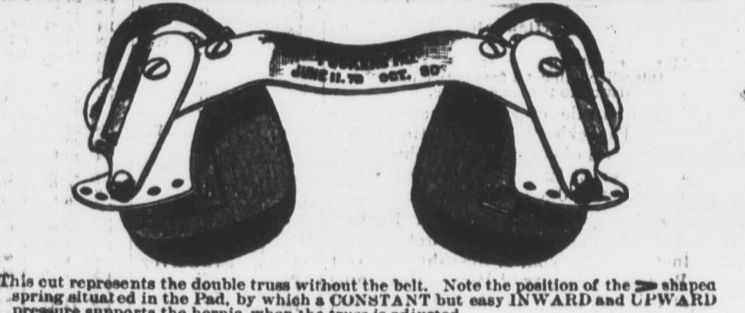

SLAVES OF QUININE.

The Growing Abuse of that Drug as Reported by an Apothecary.

"Just watch this customer," he said. The man was very thin and cadaverous looking. Without saying a word he walked up to the soda fountain, and the boy drew out a pill box, poured three pills into the palm of the customer's hand, set a glass of mineral water in front of him and turned to the next customer.

"That costs him a dollar and forty cents a week," said the proprietor, "and before long it will kill him. He started to take one five grain pill every night about six months ago; he now takes fifteen grains a night before he goes home, so that it will brace him up for his dinner."

"Have you many such regular customers?" "Well, to be accurate, we have only three men who come in every day, and there are many others who take their quinine regularly as most drinking folks take whisky."
