Where purchased, and from whom. 4. Date of Shipment. In cases where the tax of two dollars (\$82.00) imposed on January sixth by the Canadian Wheat Board has actually been paid, the Board is prepared to present any claims to the Canadian Wheat Boaird if any difflculty lis met with in the refund of same. Flour can now be purchased by Importers on terms of shipment within sixty days.
