To the Friends and Supporters of the Primitive Methodist Missions
in Canada.

CHRISTIAN FRIENDS,

In presenting to you another yearly Report of the Canadian Primitive Methodist Missionary Society, the Committee wishes to acknowledge its deep gratitude to God for the measure of prosperity which has been realized in the cause of Missions under their care, and to the friends of Missions for their increased support during the past year.

It is the Committee's anxious desire to increase the number of its agents in the Missionary work, that the cause of evangelism may extend yet more, and that a still greater number of our countrymen may be brought to a knowledge of saving truth. We believe God has committed the gospel to the church, with the obligation for her to propagate it through the earth. The commission "preach the gospel to every creature," is ever binding on Christians: it is dispensational. The church is expected to disciple the world to Christ: she can never be set free from that appointed work: it is as much obligatory on the church now, as it was when our risen Lord first gave the *great commission*. May we, as a section of the Christian church, ever remember this, and be stimulated to augmented liberality and zeal.

The Primitive Methodist Church has been signally missionary from the period of its commencement. A vast deal of Missionary work can be done, and needs to be done, apart from the employment of agency in the heathen world. Pagan lands need the gospel we know, and nominally Christian lands also need much of the Missionary enterprize. Had it not been for the Home Missionary operations of Primitive Methodism, teeming masses of England's population in many parts would have been completely neglected. They were neglected. The *highways* and *hedges* had been forsaken by the then existing Methodist churches, as well as by others. In the providence of God heroic, earnest men arose in connection with the Primitive Methodist Church; bands of them went through the length and breadth of most of the counties of England, thirty, forty, and fifty-six years ago, while *tens of thousands* of converted souls were the *seals* of their ministry.

Besides these Home Missionary efforts, agents of this Society were sent many years since into Ireland ; into the Norman Isles ; into certain parts of the United States ; into Australia ; into New Zealand ; and into Canada. Had the mission fund of the Parent Society been strong enough thirty years since to have sent a batch of men into this land, to take different points of the country, then being settled, the probability is, Primitive Methodism in Canada would have now been a much larger and stronger cause ; but impossibilities could not be done.

During the last ten years the Canadian Primitive Methodist Missionary Society has done much missionary work, considering its numbers and means. Much has been done by this cause in the conversion of souls that does not, and cannot appear in our numerical position. In the last twelve years, between five and six thousand members have removed from Canadian Primitive Methodist Societies into parts of the country beyond our reach as a church ; while other religious societies, especially Methodist bodies, have been much benefitted numerically by accessions from the converts of Primitive Methodism. We speak facts ; and they did right to find a home in the bosom of some other part of the Church of Christ, when they were settled where their own church had not an existence : it would have been wrong not to do so. We name these facts simply to show that the Primitive Methodist Missionary Society has been of much greater use in Canada than what appears in the *present status* of the church.

God is owning the labours of many of the Missionaries now. Upon the Stations of several there have been blessed revivals, and gradual growth. Sanctuaries, Sabbath Schools, Parsonages, and new Societies are springing up as from the earth ; and had we ampler means at command, much more could be effected by the Society, in various parts of the country.

Our missions are thirty-one in number, though four have been recently made self-sustaining Circuits ; and the Missionaries are thirty-six in number, engaged on the thirty-one Mission Stations. May the Great Head of the Church vouchsafe more abundant success.
