ROBBED OF \$21,000 IN CASH.

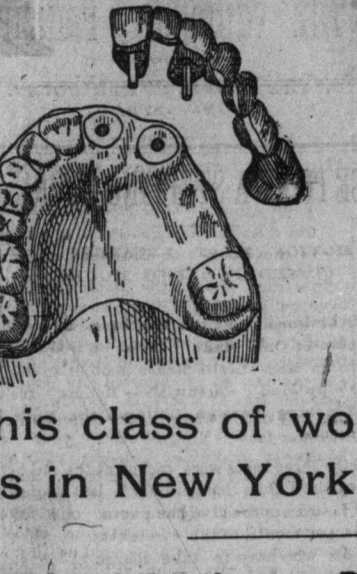
