THE CITY OF ST. THOMAS.

“The Railroad City.” Such is the appropriate name given to the Capital of the fruitful and prosperous County of Elgin. It is unnecessary to recount the history of the City from its growth as a hamlet to the dignity of a City ; but it may not be out of place to show the causes which have led to its rapid increase in population and prosperity. Foremost among these is the foresight the citizens have displayed in fostering and aiding judicious railway communication, which has opened up trade from all quarters. St. Thomas is the principal station on the Air Line, which is a loop line of the Great Western, and extends from Glencoe to Fort Erie ; on the Canada Southern, which traverses the entire southern counties from the Detroit to the Niagara Rivers, and is one of the best equipped roads on the American continent. The Port Stanley branch of the G. W. R. passes through the City, and gives communication with Lake Erie at Port Stanley. The Credit Valley railway will shortly be opened up to the City, giving the advantage of a new and independent route to Toronto.

The principal offices, locomotive and car shops of the Canada Southern railway are located here, and give employment to a very large number of workmen. The Canada Southern railway have constructed their own water-works, the pipes having been laid from “Pinafore Lake” to the depot. This lake and the property adjoining has been purchased by the Company, who have erected boiler and pump houses, &c. Hydrants are placed about the depot and workshops, so as to secure an inexhaustible supply of water in case of fire. The hydrants will also be utilized for the watering of locomotives and all general purposes about the Company’s property. The lake is distant a good mile, and the cost of the undertaking will be very considerable.

The population of East Elgin is 28,157, and West Elgin 14,214, making a total for the County of 42,371.

The *Journal*, in speaking of "The City's Progress," says:—
"The continued progress of the city is a matter of surprise to our own citizens. It surpasses the expectation of the most sanguine. The quantity of landed estate that has this past half of the year 1881 changed hands exceeds that of any other previous six months of its history. The prices, too, are in advance, but not to an extent that would indicate anything approaching inflation, or even the breath of it. There is in fact an absence of anything like speculation. Purchases are made for immediate use and not with a view to profit from a resale. There are few unoccupied houses within the

city limits, and often there are applicants for their tenancy while yet the foundation is being laid. Building operations keep pace with the demand and scarcely ever shoot ahead of it. Everyone seems fully employed, and the cry of the industrious poor is scarcely ever heard. There is every indication that the increase of population, the growth of business, the enhanced price of town lots and the enlargement of enterprise of every kind are normal in their character, and fully warranted by all the circumstances that can be considered in making up a judgment

upon the case. There can, therefore, be little chance of a re-action. The reasonable outlook is, that in four years more the population will number at least fifteen thousand, and that every other interest that combines to make up a pleasant, healthy and enterprising city will increase in a corresponding ratio. The prospects are of the most cheering character, not only to our business men but to those who are investing their capital either in real estate or in industries that partake of the general prosperity."

As a result of this progress, merchants are erecting handsome business blocks. Amongst those recently completed and in course of erection may be mentioned the Bromell Block, corner of Talbot and Metcalf; Dr. McLarty's Block, Talbot street, opposite the Post Office; J. H. Thompson & Co's Block, Dr. Smith's Block, Idsardi Block, Morse's Block, Salter's Block, and McNulty Block, all situate on Talbot street.

In consequence of the rapid growth of the "East End" of the City, the Corporation have erected a new market in that district, which has been named the Horton Market.

The Alma College (see illustration) is now completed and will be opened in the fall. It is a magnificent structure of stone and brick, and is situated at the head of Moore street.

The Government will shortly erect a new Post Office and Custom House on the corner of Talbot and Mary streets, the site at present being occupied by the Presbyterian Church. The site for the new Presbyterian Church has not yet been chosen, but the building will be very handsome and costly.

Ward No. 3.—Bounded on the west by the eastern boundary of Second Ward, on the north by the present boundary of said city, on the south by the northern boundary road allowance between the seventh and eighth concessions of the township of Yarmouth and Kettle Creek, on the east commencing at the intersection of the centre of East avenue, thence northerly along the centre of Southwick, Francis and Hiawatha streets to the southern boundary of the

Great Western Railway grounds, thence due north to a point one hundred and thirty-two feet north of the north boundary of Barwick street, produced.

Ward No. 4.—Bounded on the west by the eastern boundary of Third Ward, on the south by the northern limit of the road allowance between the seventh and eighth concessions of the township of Yarmouth, on the east by a line in the centre of Flora street, produced, north to a point one hundred and thirty-two feet north of the north boundary of Barwick street, and a line in the centre of Ross street, produced, south to the northern limit of the road allowance between the seventh and eighth concessions of the township of Yarmouth, on the north by a line one hundred and thirty-two feet north of the north boundary of Barwick street, produced.

Ward No. 5.—Bounded on the west by the eastern boundary of Fourth Ward, on the south by the northern limit of the road allowance between the seventh and eighth concessions of the township of Yarmouth, on the east by a line in the centre of Fourth avenue and a line in the centre of Balaclava street, to be produced, south to Wellington street and north to a point one hundred and thirty-two feet north of the north boundary of Barwick street, produced; on the north by a line one hundred and thirty-two feet north of the north boundary of Barwick street, produced.

Ward No. 6.—Bounded on the west by the eastern boundary of Fifth Ward, on the south by the northern limit of the road allowance between the seventh and eighth concessions of the township of Yarmouth, on the east by a line in the centre of First avenue, produced, north to a point one hundred and thirty-two feet north of the north boundary of Barwick street, produced, and produced south to the northern limit of the road allowance between the seventh and eighth concessions of the said township of Yarmouth; on the north by a line one hundred and thirty-two feet north of the north boundary of Barwick street, produced.
