The Board of Aldermen held a short session and dispersed in an hour to attend the banquet.

Returning Officers Elected—Rock Bay Bridge Again—Will the Mayor be Returned by Acclamation?

Ald. MacGregor was sufficiently recovered from his late severe illness to be able to occupy his customary seat at the council board last evening, and there was a full attendance when the mayor took the chair at 8:15.

After the minutes had been duly read and approved, the following were read as follows: From the secretary of the British Columbia Board of Trade, enclosing a few copies of the annual report of the board and asking the council's wishes in regard to the number required by the city for distribution.

John C. Darling, a confectioner, wrote a long letter commending the justice done to him by the bread sale by-law, which he believed did not apply to his business, as he made only fancy bread or cakes.

His worship did not see how the council could remit fines, but Ald. Williams thought it was never too late to fight a Kluksong. Ald. Humphrey thought it was no hardship in the case; he had heard that the hardship was in the last case and upon the city.

Ald. Bragg asked if the city solicitor had communicated to the B. C. Electric Railway Co. the resolution passed at the last meeting, and was informed that he had, no reply being expected until the superintendent in Vancouver had been referred to.

Applications were received for positions of polling clerks and were referred to Mr. Northcott, and a list of applicants for deputy returning officers was received from him.

RUSSIAN BEAR IN CHINA

Russians hurriedly placing Port Arthur and Tientsin in a State of Defence—Vast Army in Manchuria.

Consider Their Position Critical Until the Trans-Siberian Railway is Completed—Manchurian Railway Begun.

Despatches to the Japan Advertiser, files of which were received by the Empress of India from North China, say that during the past month the Russians have been working with feverish haste in order to place Port Arthur and Tientsin in a state of defence, their position in the Far East being considered precarious.
