The Philatelic Mania.

Every person who has paid the slightest attention to the interesting science of Phrenology knows that among the different sections or organs of the brain, each devoted to a separate passion or distinct function, there is one called the organ of acquisitiveness, which finds its gratification in searching after and treasuring up some particular class of things which happen to take its fancy. No wonder, therefore, that among all classes of professions and trades, from the highest to the lowest, we find collectors, whose names are well known to those who administer to their so called "hobbies." One of the most fashionable of the quiet-minded pursuits of the present day—and which bids fair to extend itself over the universe—is the collection of stamps. It is a quiet pursuit, light, composed, reflective, and what is more, it is instructive. It conduces to an acquisition of a good deal beyond stamps only—a knowledge of geography, a knowledge of the advancement of civilization, for the first adoption of the stamp system in any country marks a great and pregnant era in its progress; a knowledge of the different kingdoms, commonwealths and republics of the world, a knowledge of the fall of dynasties, the death of rulers, and the appointment of their successors. Neither is it without interest to the student of the fine arts, as it is curious to note and compare the talent or want of it exhibited by different nations in the art of engraving, as evinced in the devices on the stamp.

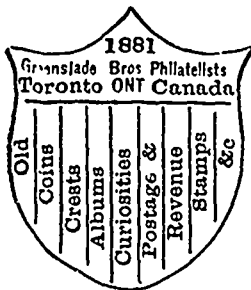

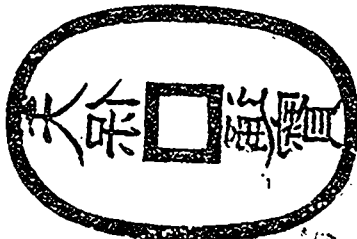

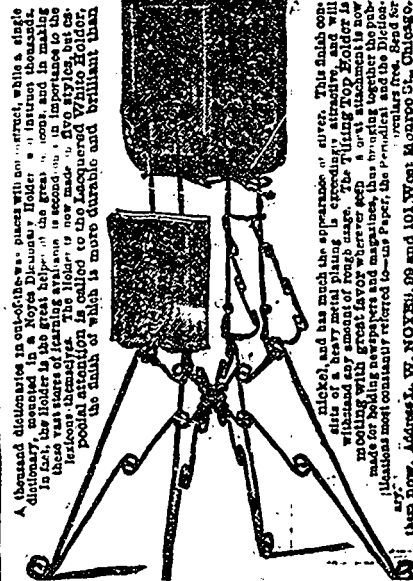
