ORDER OF PROCEEDING AT MEETINGS.

1. Reading minutes of the preceding meeting, which, when approved of, shall be signed by the presiding officer.
2. Reading of Correspondence.
3. Transaction of Business arising out of the Minutes.
4. Reports of Committees.
5. Proposal and Election of Members.
6. Payment of Dues.
7. Unfinished Business.
8. New Business.
9. Adjournment.

BY-LAWS.

1. The President shall be *ex officio* chairman of all meetings, ordinary or special, where he shall be present.
2. In case of the absence of the President, the Vice-Presidents shall preside, taking rank by seniority.
3. Should neither President nor Vice-President be present at any meeting, ordinary or extra-ordinary, the members present may elect a member to preside, who, for the time being, shall be clothed with the powers of the President.
4. In case of two members rising to address the meeting at the same time, the presiding officer shall decide who has the floor.
5. Any member addressing the meeting shall do so through the chairman or presiding officer, who shall not occupy the floor more than fifteen minutes without special license.
6. At all meetings the chair is to be taken punctually at the hour appointed; and in case thirty minutes shall elapse without a quorum, the meeting will stand adjourned until such time as the members present shall name and appoint.
7. The Secretary shall take minutes of all meetings and read them at the next regular meeting, in order to their correction or confirmation.
8. The Treasurer shall take charge of all dues, fees and funds, disbursing them under the direction of the officers and on the order of the President, being prepared to report at any regular meeting the state of the finances.

CONSTITUTION
OF THE
YORK PIONEERS' ASSOCIATION.

1.—This organization shall be called the YORK PIONEERS' SOCIETY, and is formed for the purpose of more intimately uniting in friendly relations those who are natives of, or who emigrated to, the original County of York, in the former Province of Upper Canada, or to this city previous to its incorporation, March 6th, 1834, and change of name from York to Toronto, and their descendants on attaining the age of forty years; (eligibility for membership, by resolutions passed 5th January, 1886, is extended to 6th of March, 1844, and their descendants, etc., which reads as follows:—"That the date of admission to the York Pioneer Society, be extended ten years; so that residents of the original County of York, up to 6th of March, 1844, will now be eligible for membership; and if desired, the eligibility for membership may be extended ten years at the end of each decade, dating from 1834).” And for preserving and perpetuating by re-publication and otherwise such historical recollections and incidents, documents and pictorial illustrations relating to the early settlement of this country and city aforesaid, as are worthy of being rescued from oblivion; and by the contribution of communications on these and kindred subjects to be read at the meetings of the Society and afterwards printed in the public journals and otherwise.

2.—This Society shall consist of a President, five Vice-Presidents, a Secretary, and Treasurer, with a Managing Committee of nine, elected from the ordinary members, of which Committee the officers of the Society are *ex-officio* members.

3.—The direction of the affairs of the Association, including the election of officers, and the admission of members, and the disposal of its funds, shall be vested in the Society at the general or ordinary meetings of the members.

4.—Every candidate for admission to the Society shall be proposed and seconded at an ordinary meeting of the Society; and may be elected at the following ordinary or general meeting by a majority of the members present on the occasion.

5.—Every member on being elected shall, either personally or through his mover or seconder, pay his annual subscription of one dollar, previous to his name being entered on the roll of members; and a member's subscription shall date from the first of January preceding his election. Any member who shall refuse or neglect to pay his dues for two years after they have accrued, provided he has been notified of his delinquency by the Secretary, shall be considered as having withdrawn himself from the Society; and the Secretary shall erase his name from the list of members.

6.—Honorary members may be elected on the recommendation of the Managing Committee, but shall not be entitled to vote or hold office.

7.—A general meeting of the Society shall be held annually, on the first Tuesday in March, for the reception of Financial (the Financial year ending the 31st December in each and every year) and other Reports; and for the election of the President, Vice-Presidents, Secretary and Treasurer, the Committee of Management and two Auditors. In case of any vacancies occurring during the year, by death or otherwise, the Society at the next monthly meeting may appoint a person or persons to fill such vacancy.

8.—The Society shall hold ordinary meetings for the despatch of business on the first Tuesday in every month, at the hour of two o'clock p.m., when the presence of seven members shall be necessary to form a quorum.

9.—A special meeting of the Society may be called by the President upon a requisition signed by at least three members, which meeting shall be competent to entertain only the business for which it was specially called.

10.—The Society shall, at any of its ordinary meetings, have power to amend its Constitution and make or alter a By-Law, on giving three months' notice of such proposed change, and its then moved, seconded and adopted by the majority present on such occasion.

11.—No subjects involving difference in religion or party politics shall be considered proper for discussion.
