## Pastoral Letter.



DEAR FRIENDS,—On coming to this circuit a year ago it was a pleasant surprise to find the parsonage through your most commendable energy sufficiently near completion to admit of immediate occupancy.

The work of the year was undertaken in dependence upon God and with full realization of the difficulties involved in following one who had been in charge four years and who was familiar with all the affairs of the church and intimately acquainted with all the members of the congregation.

So far as the work of the church during the year can be represented in reports, you will find it set forth in the following pages which I hope you will carefully peruse.

Since returns were made to the District meeting in May 1898, eight of our members have died, viz.—Mrs. T.W. Belot, Mrs. C. Rivett, Mrs. J. K. Ried, Messrs. James Brown, S. Brady, W. Daniels, S. Evans, and J. Smeaton. There has also been an unusually large number of removals to other places, yet a slight increase in the membership of the church is reported.

It has been a peculiar pleasure to welcome to the fellowship of our church so many from other circuits.

I have been greatly encouraged in my public ministry by your regular attendance at the Sunday and mid-week services and I most sincerely hope for its continuance.

The cheerfulness and liberality which you have contributed to the various funds of the church is worthy of great praise and has been duly appreciated by the members of the Quarterly and Trustee Board.

In behalf of the effort now being made to pay the floating debt on the church in connection with the 20th century



scheme, let me bespeak your most hearty and general co-operation.

For the words of cheer I have received, and for the great assistance rendered by the officials of the church, the Ladies Aid Society and the choir, I am devoutly thankful.

The Sunday School, the various branches of the Epworth League of Christian Endeavour and the several society classes I commend to you prayerful sympathy, loyal support and kindly help.

As the home precedes the church and the spiritual life of the individual member precedes church work. I would most sincerely call your attention to the proper management of the one and the careful cultivation of the other.

In entering upon another year let us band ourselves more closely together in earnest effort to do the work God in his providence has assigned us.

Many strangers join us in our services on the Lord's Day ; to these let us be careful to show a friendly spirit.

And now I commend you to God and to the word of His grace, which is able to build you up and give you an inheritance among all them that are sanctified.

## Report of E. L. of C. E.

---

In presenting this our annual report, we do so with gratitude to God for the most encouraging and prosperous year in the history of our society. Our devotional exercises are characterized by an earnestness and sincerity which augurs well for the future of our church and the advancement of the work in this portion of our Master's vineyard. Our membership has largely increased, and while we are deeply thankful for this, we would not, and do not, overlook the great necessity of the deepening of the spiritual life of all. We realize the work of our society pre-eminently, to be the salvation of our fellow-men, and for this purpose we meet from week to week in fellowship and communion with God to ask His blessing and strength to carry on this work.

We have recognized during the past year the necessity of organizing an Intermediate department in connection with our Society, and which, although but recently formed, gives promises of great benefit in our work and to form a necessary link in the chain of Christian development and preparation for future service.

Our Junior department is also in a most satisfactory and encouraging condition and we cannot too strongly recommend the members and friends of our church to send their children to one of these societies in all of which strangers receive a most cordial and hearty welcome.

The Missionary and Finance committees are enabled also, by the grace of God, to report the most satisfactory year in our existence. We have raised for all purposes the sum of \$119.50, which, when considered that all is voluntary, and most of our members are contributing otherwise to God's work, we deem most praiseworthy. To the Missionary Fund of our church we have contributed \$42.00 during the year.

Other committees connected with our work report also most favorably, and we are led to believe that God approves of our humble efforts to carry on the work in this portion of His vineyard.

We are pleased to report our membership as follows: Senior--Active, 56; Associate, 30; 86. Intermediate--Active, 9; Associate, 3; 12. Junior--Active, 34; Associate, 4; 38. Total membership 136.

Under the supervision of the prayer meeting committee, sanctioned of and supported by the members of the society, a meeting is conducted at the Protestant Home for the Aged, Bank St., every Thursday evening from 6.45 to 7.45 o'clock to which service a cordial invitation is extended, indeed we would ask the presence of all who can possibly attend. We feel that our aged brethren appreciate these efforts to help them, and trust the seed sown may yield an abundant harvest.

Although our organization is supposedly a young peoples society, we always extend the heartiest welcome to the older members who



may find time and inclination to attend our services. We are always glad of their words of encouragement and advice, and consider that a more intimate acquaintance in Christian work of the older with the younger workers would be productive of the greatest good and result in mutual benefit. We extend therefore to those who will meet with us an earnest invitation to do so.
