CONSTITUTION AND BY-LAWS
OF THE
ONTARIO RIFLE ASSOCIATION.

CONSTITUTION.

1. That this Association be denominated "The Ontario Rifle Association."
2. Any person being a subscriber of \$1 per annum, shall become a member of the Association.
3. Donors of \$20 at one time to the funds of the Association, or of a prize of not less value than \$40, to be competed for at the annual prize meeting, shall be entitled to be enrolled as life members of the Association.
4. Any Battalion or Rifle Association in the Province subscribing not less than \$10 annually to the funds of the Association, shall be considered as being in connection with it, and shall be entitled to a number of memberships in the proportion of one to every half-dollar thus subscribed. Each subscribing Association is to elect from its members the persons to hold such memberships, and return their names and addresses, when elected, to the Secretary of the Association, to be registered by him one week previous to the match.
5. There shall be a Patron and Vice-Patrons named by the Council.
The Lieut-Governor of the Province of Ontario, for the time being, shall be respectfully requested to become "Patron."
6. There shall be a President.
7. There shall be four Vice-Presidents, one for each Military District.

8. There shall be a Council, composed as follows :—

1st. Four members from each of the Military Districts who shall be elected primarily at this meeting, and hereafter at the annual meeting.

2nd. The Brigade Majors.

3rd. The Presidents of local affiliated Associations and Clubs, being members of the Association—

Five of whom shall form a quorum ; and in the event of vacancies occurring in the elective members from any cause whatever, the remaining members of the Council shall have the power of filling such vacancies.

9. The Council shall choose from the members elected the President of the Association.

10. There shall be a Vice-President for each Military District, selected from among the members of the Council for such District, and who shall be elected by the Council.

11. There shall be a Treasurer, and there shall be a Secretary at Toronto, both to be appointed by the Council, and holding office during pleasure.

12. The Council shall have the sole management of the income and funds of the Association, rendering an account to the yearly meeting—such account having been previously audited by a person or persons not members of the Council, who shall be annually named by the Council for that purpose. The Council shall also have the entire management and superintendence of all the affairs and concerns of the Association, and shall or may do all such acts and deeds as shall appear to them necessary or essential to be done for the purpose of carrying into effect the object and views of the Association.

13. The Council shall be regulated in their proceedings by such by-laws as may from time to time be enacted by them ; no by-law being, in any case, altered, or new one proposed, without at least one month's notice of such intention being given to each member of Council.

14. The annual prize meeting shall be held at such times and places as may be determined on by the Council.

15. The prizes shall be competed for in accordance with such regulations as may be passed by the Council from time to time.

16. An annual report, embracing the audited account of the finances, shall be drawn up by the Secretary, and shall (having been previously submitted to the Council) be published as soon after the prize meeting as may be found practicable.
17. There shall be an annual meeting, to be held at such time and place as shall be selected by the Council.

Extract from Minutes of Council, held at Toronto, Dec. 7, 1869.

"Resolved,—That the sum of twenty dollars be paid as a bonus to each Association affiliating with the Ontario Rifle Association during the current financial year, upon the condition that the Association so affiliated, before receiving the said grant, and before the next annual meeting of this Association (June 21st, '70) shall hold a prize meeting on its own ranges, and shall make a duly attested return of the scores then made by the competitors at such match; and upon the further condition that not less than Forty Dollars (\$40) shall be distributed in prizes at such competition."

Secretaries of Rifle Associations affiliated, or desirous of affiliating with the Ontario Rifle Association, will confer a favor by forwarding the names and addresses of the office-bearers of their Association, as soon after their election as possible, in order that they may be published in the annual report.

BY-LAWS.

The next annual meeting of the Association shall be held at Toronto, on the Third Tuesday in June, 1870.

There shall be two ordinary meetings of the Council; the first of which shall be held on the day after the annual meeting of the Association, and the second at such other time as the Council may then determine upon.

Extraordinary meetings shall be summoned by the Secretary, if required by any six of the members of the Council—notification being sent to each member of the Council at least ten days previous to such meeting—and the requisition for the meeting, and the notices to the members, must state the object or objects of such extraordinary meeting.

The Council shall keep minutes of its proceedings at all meetings, which shall be entered in a book kept for that purpose by the Secretary, and open to the inspection of any members of the Council.

There shall be a Finance Committee, consisting of ~~three~~ members of the Council.

The Treasurer is authorized to deposit from time to time in the Savings Department of the Ontario Bank, all sums of money paid over to him on behalf of the Association.

All expenditure of sums for current expenses which may be required by the Secretary, must be authorized by the signature of the President of the Association, or, in his absence, by some member of the Finance Committee, and the Treasurer shall pay all orders duly signed in such manner.

Other expenditures of a general nature are to be made only upon the authority of the Council of the Association,

A detailed statement of all receipts and Expenditures shall be rendered annually to the Council by the Treasurer.

REPORT OF COUNCIL
OF THE
ONTARIO RIFLE ASSOCIATION,
1869.

It having been considered desirable that a Rifle Association should be formed in the Province of Ontario, for the purpose of encouraging Rifle practice as a means towards a national defence ; a meeting was held in the St. Lawrence Hall, Toronto, on the 30th April, 1868, consisting of delegates from the various military districts of Ontario. This meeting adopted a constitution, and elected a Council of 16 members, four from each military district. Subsequently the Council met, and having elected C. S. Gzowski, Esq., President, a Vice-President for each district, with the other officers of the Association ; passed a resolution that the first prize meeting of the Ontario Rifle Association should be held in the Autumn of the same year. But owing to circumstances, this was found to be impracticable, and on the 22nd April, 1869, a meeting of the Council was held in the President's Office, at which it was resolved to hold the First Prize Meeting in Toronto, on the 22nd June following. Through the exertions of the President, a number of Snider Enfield Rifles, and a large supply of ammunition had been procured from the Imperial Government ; and it was resolved that these rifles, with a grant of \$20 should be awarded to affiliating Associations as special prizes from the Association, and as a premium towards the encouragement of Local Associations.

The Government, through the Hon. Sir George Cartier, Minister of Militia, having authorized a grant of eighteen hundred dollars in aid of the funds of the Association, and the County Councils of the counties of Wentworth, Huron, Halton, Brant, Wellington, Welland, Lanark, Victoria, Bruce, Oxford, Northumberland and Ontario, having each voted the sum of twenty-five dollars—this amount, together with the liberal donations of His Excellency

the Lieut.-Governor, Major General Stisted, C.B., Hon. D. L. Macpherson, and the President of the Association, C. S. Gzowski, Esq., enabled the Council to offer for competition a most attractive Prize List, comprising a Silver Cup, presented by His Excellency the Governor General ; a magnificent Silver Challenge Cup, value, \$200, presented by Messrs. Aldwell & Co ; other Cups and Prizes valued at \$104 ; sixteen Snider Enfields and 1,500 rounds of ammunition, together with \$1,530 in money.

The Garrison Common, Toronto, having been selected as the place of meeting, arrangements upon a large scale were made for the accommodation of competitors ; contracts were entered into for the supply of refreshments at moderate prices, and camp equipage was borrowed from the Imperial and Militia stores. Tradesmen being invited to ply their trades on the ground, a number availed themselves of the permission of the Council, and erected tents.

Twelve butts on the Hill system were constructed, in addition to Pool and other Ranges ; six having a range of 1,000 yards ; two of 800, and four of 500 yards. The system of disc-marking gave very general satisfaction. The marking parties were supplied from the 1st Battalion 60th Rifles.

For the maintenance of order and discipline, the camp was placed under the charge of Lieut.-Col. R. B. Denison, Brigade Major.

The match was opened on the 22nd inst. by His Excellency the Lieut.-Governor of Ontario firing the first shot.

The total number of competitors on the ground during the matches was estimated at 500—the representatives of over thirty affiliated Associations.

The weather during the continuance of the matches was very favorable, although strong north-west winds prevailed, rendering

the shooting on the second and third days of the match less steady than it might otherwise have been.

The shooting throughout all the matches was, however, above the average, and in some cases exceptionally good.

The Battalion Match and Aldwell Challenge Trophy, was won by the 2nd Battalion Queen's Own Rifles, Toronto—a member of the same corps also winning the Governor General's Cup.

It is a matter of great satisfaction to be able to report, that although the matches extended over six days, no accident occurred to mar the pleasure which attended this first and most successful prize meeting of the Ontario Rifle Association.

The thanks of the Association are due to Lieut. General Sir Charles Wyndham, K.C.B., for his uniform and continued kindness in promoting the objects of the Association ; to Col. Jenyns C.B., 13th Hussars, and the Officers of the Toronto Garrison, for their cordial assistance and co-operation in carrying out the arrangements for the meeting ; to the gentlemen composing the Committee of Arrangements and Firing Committee, for their untiring exertions in arranging and carrying out the matches to a successful issue ; to Lieut. Col. R. B. Denison, Brigade Major, for his tact and energy as the Executive Officer of the match ; to Major Croft as Statistical Officer, and to the Grand Trunk, Great Western and Northern Railway Companies, for their liberality in conveying competitors to and from the matches at a single fare.

The annual meeting of the Association, adjourned from the 22nd June, took place on the 25th instant, at which the following report was presented :—

" Your Council have little to report as to the proceedings of the Association, owing to the fact that, having been organized only last year, circumstances have not, as yet, permitted of a prize meeting.

" A Provincial match is however, fixed for the 22nd June inst., and from the report of the Committee of Arrangements, herewith submitted, the meeting promises to be a successful one in every way.

" The present report is, therefore, preliminary, and will be supplemented by a fuller one, embodying the details of the above match, and bringing up the proceedings of the Association to the close of 1869.

"Your Council have much pleasure in recording the liberality of the Dominion Government, in making a donation last year of \$1,800 to the funds of the Association.

"Without this grant, such has been the apathy generally on the part of riflemen throughout the Province towards the Association, that it would have been difficult, if not impossible, to get up the necessary funds for a prize meeting.

"Your Council feel bound to regret the want of interest generally on the part of the public, (particularly among the volunteers) in the success of this Association.

"As an evidence of this your attention is called to the fact that the Treasurer's statement herewith submitted, shows only \$63 as having been received up to the 19th instant, for memberships.

"It is probable that this apathy arises to a considerable extent from a preference on the part of riflemen generally, to encourage Associations nearer home.

"Your Council express the hope, however, that when the policy and objects of the Provincial Association are better understood, it will be seen that there exists no cause for jealousy; that, on the contrary, the principal object which the latter has in view is to encourage and promote the usefulness of local Associations.

"Your Council submit the following resolution, passed at a meeting on the 22nd April last, in proof of this, that is to say:—

"That each corps of Volunteer Militia or Rifle Association, which may have affiliated with the Provincial Association by the 1st day of June next, shall receive from the Council the sum of twenty dollars, and those Associations to the number of fifteen, which may have first affiliated, shall receive a Snider Rifle and 250 rounds of ammunition in addition."

"The undermentioned Associations and Battalions have affiliated with the Provincial Association to the present date, that is to say, 1868:—Aug. 26—St. Catharines; Sept. 10, Cobourg; Nov. 4, Brookville; Dec. 23, Haldimand. 1869.—April 21, Guelph; 24, 13th Battalion; 24, Toronto Club; 24, County of Peel; 26, Victoria; 26, Hamilton; 26, Peterboro'; 26, London; 26, Queen's Own; 27, Wardsville; 28, Perth; 28, Ontario; 28, Ingersoll; 20, 40th Battalion. "The prize rifles given to the Local Association were obtained from the War Department, not however, without much trouble, through the efforts of the President, when in England last summer.

"The President has also succeeded, through the kindness of Gen. Wyndham, commanding the regular forces in the Dominion, in obtaining in this country, the Snider Rifles offered as prizes at the ensuing match.

"It will be seen that the Association is indebted to His Excellency, Sir John Young, Governor General ; to Major-General Stisted, late Lieutenant Governor, who kindly consented to be Patron ; to His Excellency Lieutenant-Governor Howland, our present Patron ; to the President ; to the Hon. D. L. Macpherson ; to Messrs. Aldwell & Co ; and to others, for generous contributions to the Prize List to be competed for at the coming matches."

C. S. Gzowski, Esq., Toronto ; Lieut. Col. Fairbanks, Oshawa ; Lieut.-Col. Skinner, Hamilton ; and Major Croft, Toronto ; for the second district. Lieut.-Col. Boulton, Cobourg ; Capt. Webb, Brighton ; Capt. Werner, Kingston ; Rev. V. Clementi, Peterboro' ; for the third district. Lieut.-Col. Buell, Brockville ; Hon. J. S. Macdonald, Cornwall ; Lieut.-Col. Forrest, Ottawa ; and W. J. Morris, Perth ; for the fourth district. J. Graham, Esq., Toronto, and J. J. Mason, Esq., Hamilton, were appointed Auditors for the present year.

The meeting then adjourned.

At a subsequent meeting of the Council, Mr. Gzowski was unanimously elected as President. Judge Macdonald, Guelph, as Vice-President for the first district ; Lieut.-Col. Skinner, Hamilton, for the second district ; Lieut.-Col. Paton, Kingston, for the third district ; and the Hon. J. S. Macdonald, Cornwall, for the fourth district.

It is a matter of great satisfaction to be able to report that the team selected by Major Croft to represent this Association in the Provincial match, at the Dominion of Canada Rifle Association matches, proved the wisdom of the selection, by winning the first prize of \$600, which was awarded in that match.

It is with great regret that this Association loses the valuable services of Lieut.-Col. Dennis, formerly Secretary of the Association ; he having been compelled to resign the office, in consequence of receiving an appointment in the Red River Territory. Through his whole tenure of office, the zeal, energy, and courtesy of this gentleman, won for the Association, as well as himself personally, the respect and consideration of all with whom he was brought in contact.

The Council have great satisfaction in stating that they have been so fortunate as to secure the services of Major T. C. Scoble, as Secretary for this Association.
