*Letter from Sir Wm. Young.*

HALIFAX, 27th Jan. 1873.

*My Dear Sir,—*

I am much obliged by your note of the 24th, enclosing the Report of the Librarian of the Citizen's Free Library for the past year. I have read also the several reports that have been made since the Library was founded in 1864, and at the recent meeting when Your Worship and the six Gentlemen, composing the Committee, did me the honor of calling on me, I was gratified to find that the benefits of the Institution were so justly and so warmly appreciated. It is still on a humble scale compared with other Free Libraries in the larger and more populous cities of the Dominion and the United States; they reckon their books by tens of thousands, while about four thousand only is the extent of ours, yet it has done good service and yielded a large amount of instruction and innocent enjoyment with narrow means.

Upwards of 1500 persons have entered their names on its books and partaken of its privileges, and its annual issues have varied from 7 to 10 thousand volumes, an average of 150 to 200 a week. I am delighted therefore to learn that, in place of the present small and inconvenient apartment the Committee are prepared to submit to the City Council of which they are members, a proposition to lease for library and reading room purposes a commodious building in a central position, which will render the Institution accessible and better known to the community, and induce benefactions and gifts as in other cities for the use of all classes, but especially of the young men and women in our manufactories, shops and households, whose nights would be much better occupied in making themselves acquainted with the stores of learning and genius which the English and American classics so abundantly supply, rather than with a succession of spectacles, not always of the most edifying kind, in which so much of their time and substance is wasted.

My late brother George had a room fitted up for a library well known to many of the citizens, comprising several hundred volumes, and especially rich in Colonial literature. This still remains under my charge, and some years ago I agreed to purchase it from the Heirs, at a valuation and offered



it to the then Government as an addition to the Citizen's Free Library if they would find suitable accommodation in the Province Building. This it was found impossible to accomplish, but now that the Committee have come forward so handsomely, I beg to renew the offer of this second library as a free gift, on their proposition being ratified as I have no doubt it will be, by the members of the City Council.

*Extract from Minutes of City Council, Halifax, Feb. 19, 1864.*

Read communication from His Honor the Chief Justice, submitted this day, when the following resolution is introduced:—

*Whereas*, His Honor the Chief Justice has generously offered to place at the disposal of the City Council, for the free use of the citizens a Library, containing upwards of 3000 volumes of valuable and standard works; and whereas the use of such a Library is calculated to be of great advantage to the community by encouraging a taste for literature and useful knowledge.

*Therefore Resolved*, That the offer of His Honor be accepted, and that the grateful thanks of this community be tendered to His Honor for his very liberal and handsome donation for the benefit of his fellow citizens.

Moved by Alderman Jennings and seconded by Alderman Conway, which on being put is passed, and a copy of the same directed to be transmitted to His Honor.

# RULES AND REGULATIONS

FOR THE USE OF THE

## ***CITIZENS' FREE LIBRARY.***

---

1. The Library shall until further notice be open from 3.15 p. m., until 6 p. m., every secular day, except Saturdays, and such days as are regarded as Holidays by the City Government, or when the Committee may see fit to close it for cleaning or inspection.
2. The Library shall be free for the use of the citizens of Halifax, under the following regulations: All inhabitants of the City over the age of twenty-one, known to the Librarian as proper persons to enjoy its privileges, or so duly certified in writing by some responsible citizen.
3. Any Minor over the age of fourteen depositing with the Librarian a written guarantee from their parents, or guardians, being themselves entitled to the privileges of the Library as above.
4. Any citizen entitled to the use of the Library can introduce a stranger who wishes either to consult books in the Library or take them to his lodgings to read; a book will be kept in which such citizen will be required to enter his own name and that of his friend, which entry will be held as a guarantee for the conduct of his friend and the safety of any book or books taken out of the Library on loan.
5. Or strangers visiting the city may have the use of the Library, on depositing with the Librarian a written guarantee from a responsible citizen, for the safety of any books loaned to them, or by depositing the value of the book, or books, or of the sett to which they belong; (optional with the Managers of the Library), the money so deposited, or guarantee to be returned when the books are returned uninjured.
6. Books must be asked for according to their designation in the Catalogue which will be supplied by the Librarian at 25 cents each.

7. Any person entitled to the use of the Library whose name and place of residence has been duly recorded, can have books by sending to the Librarian in writing, (with their proper signatures attached) the name of the book required, or the names of several to be selected from.

8. No person can take books from the shelves who is not employed in the service of the Library.

9. The time books may be kept will be marked in them, also the amount of fine for each day over-kept, which will be strictly enforced, but the book may be renewed on application provided it is not required by another applicant.

10. Any book detained without renewal one week beyond the time limited by these regulations may be sent for by the Librarian at the expense of the person so detaining it, which together with the fine incurred must be paid before any further issue is made.

11. All losses or injuries to books shall be made good to the satisfaction of the Librarian, and any books after three months detention will be held to be lost, and no person owing a fine incurred as above can be entitled to the further use of the Library until such fines be paid or losses made good.

12. Encyclopaedias, Dictionaries, Bound Newspapers, or other books of reference, can only be used in the Library, except under special circumstances and conditions optional with the managers of the Library. All books must be returned to the Library whenever required for inspection or otherwise, under a penalty of one dollar for each volume detained. Reasonable notice will always be given in such cases.
