Fifty young men, members of the Socialist Singing Society sang "The Weavers," the song that Engel sang in the court room in Chicago. After that the band played the "Marseillaise."

This is not the time to cheer nor the time to applaud, neither is it the time to weep, but the time to think and to get ready for action. It is not the time to enquire into the political or social condition of those who have been hanged in Chicago. Many of us may not have accepted their verdict, but it is the time for us to ask how they lived, how they died, and why they died.
