

THE PASSING OF HOME RULE.

FROM THE SUNDAY WORLD. HOW THE PEERS WILL DEAL WITH THE MEASURE.

Mr. Gladstone's Intentions - Sections of His Party Becoming Very Restless - Domestic Legislation Demanded - Votes Determined - Have a Disastrous Effect - Tactics of the Opposition.

Home Rule Carried. LONDON, Sept. 3.—The personal enthusiasm of Mr. Gladstone has carried Home Rule through the House of Commons. This great triumph is, however, gravely discounted when it is remembered that the success has been achieved by the Irish vote alone, and that for the application of the measure to the rest of the United Kingdom, a majority of the voters in Great Britain would have to be won.

THE WELSH COAL STRIKE. Seventy Thousand Return to Work - Thirty Thousand Still Idle - The "Pit Wars" Shut Down.

LONDON, Sept. 3.—Home rule movements in South Wales and Monmouthshire have gone back to the collieries. In some 70,000 men, who struck for a 30 per cent. advance in wages, are now at work again, with the scale in operation. The total loss of wages during the strike has been £2,000,000.

THE ARGENTINE-BRAZIL DISPUTE. President Cleveland Requested to Act as Arbitrator in the Matter.

NEW YORK, Sept. 3.—Estimacio Zeballos, Envoy Extraordinary and Minister Plenipotentiary of the Argentine Republic to the U.S., is in the city. He is on his way to the U.S. to request President Cleveland to act as arbitrator in a territorial dispute between the Argentine Republic and Brazil.
