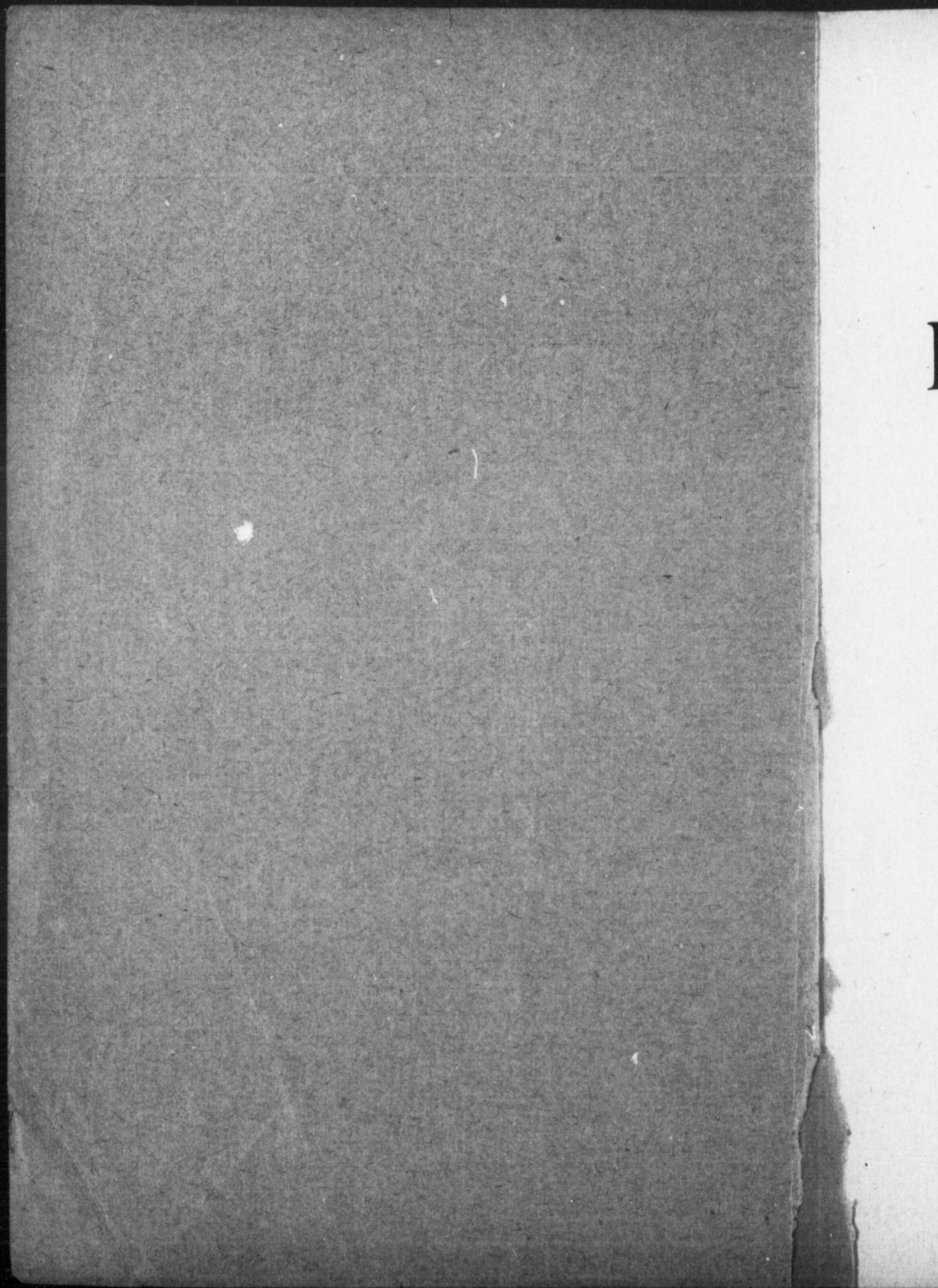

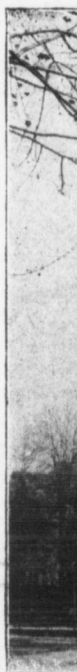

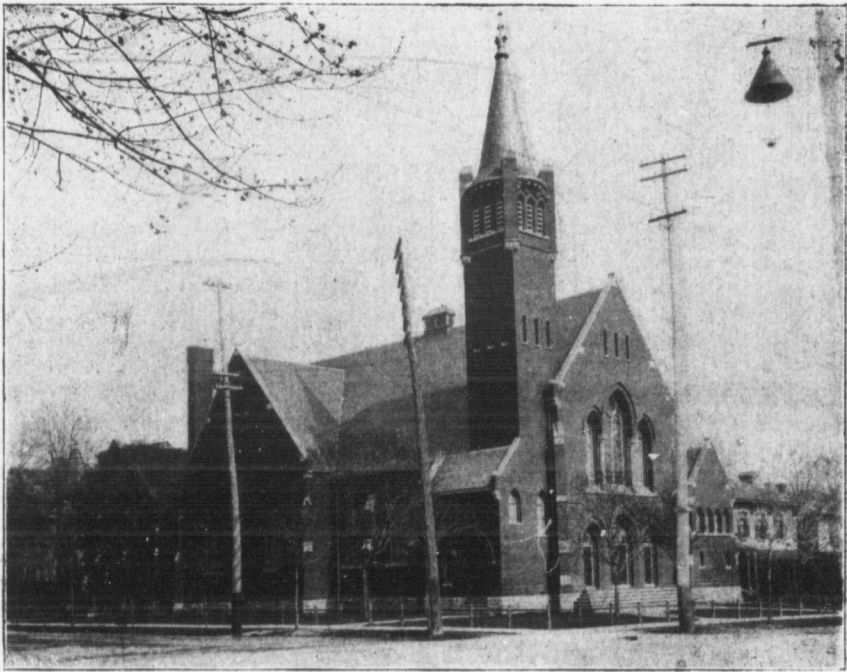

## CONSTITUTION.

---

**T**HIS congregation shall be known by the name of the First Presbyterian Church, Park Avenue.

The Board of Managers shall be chosen by ballot by the congregation from among the members in full communion, and adherents as distinguished from communicants, at the annual meeting of the congregation or at a meeting duly called for that purpose. Not more than one-third of the members of the Board, at any time, to consist of non-communicants.

The Board of Managers shall consist of twelve members, one-half of whom shall retire annually by rotation ; and their places, as also the places of any who may die or vacate their office during the year, shall be filled at the annual meeting of the congregation. The retiring Managers may be re-elected.

If any Manager be cut off from Church privileges by process of discipline, or leave the congregation, he shall forthwith cease to act as Manager, and another shall, as soon as convenient, be appointed in his place.

The duty of the Managers shall be to attend to the temporal and financial affairs of the congregation. More particularly it shall be their duty to obtain from the people contributions for the sustentation of the ministry ; to take care of the property of the congregation ; to provide for the payment of the minister's and other salaries ; and generally to administer all matters committed to their charge, as the congregation may from time to time direct.

Meetings of the Board shall be held on the last Wednesday of each month for the transaction of business; but a meeting may be held at any time on the call of the chairman, by notice from the pulpit, or addressed personally to the members of the Board.

Five members present shall constitute a quorum. Every meeting should be opened and closed with prayer.

The Treasurer shall be appointed at the annual meeting of the congregation from the members of the Board of Managers. His duties shall be to keep the accounts of the congregation and to receive and disburse all moneys, subject to the direction and control of the Board of Managers.

The Chairman and Secretary shall be appointed by the Board of Managers at the first meeting of the Board held after the annual meeting of the congregation.

The Chairman's duties shall be to preside at the meetings of the Board of Managers, and to sign all accounts which have passed the Board. In his absence any member may be chosen to act as chairman *pro tem*. The Chairman has only a casting vote.

The Secretary's duties shall be to keep a correct record of the proceedings of the Board of Managers, to act as clerk of the congregation at congregational meetings, and to keep a correct account of all business transactions, financial and otherwise, connected with the secular affairs of the Church.

All cases not herein provided for shall be governed by the rules and forms of the procedure laid down by the Church courts of the Presbyterian Church in Canada.

## SESSION STATEMENT.

---

It cannot be forgotten that we have entered upon not only a new year, but also a new century, and it is natural also to remember at this time that in one more year the congregation of the First Presbyterian Church will have attained the age that is allotted to man, seventy years. As we look back we have great reason to give thanks for all that God has wrought for us and by us, and forward with hope and courage. It is impossible to enter into a detailed review here, but inasmuch as the present pastorate is now over a decade old, it is interesting to note the fact that from a total revenue of some \$3,000 at the end of 1889, the receipts went up to some \$10,000 at the end of 1899. The membership has also increased from less than 200 at the end of 1889 to 486 reported at the end of 1899, and this notwithstanding the heavy drain there has been upon the membership by deaths and removals.

The representatives of the oldest generation have been taken away very rapidly the last few years. During the year just closed Mr. Adam Murray, an elder and member since 1835; Mr. Robert Reid, active in the affairs of the congregation since 1840; Mrs. William Grieve, also an old-time member; and Mr. Andrew Denholm, sexton for over thirty-seven years, have been called away. With great regret we have been called upon to suffer the loss of Mr. H. M. Lay from the session and congregation. Messrs. A. A. Maver, T. B. Miller and A. P. Templeton have been an added strength to the Session, and will be increasingly useful.



There have been fourteen deaths in the families of the congregation, five of these being little children. The Lord hath been calling the lambs home to His heavenly fold. Fifty-three have been granted certificates of disjunction. There have been fourteen baptisms during the year.

The Session have been greatly encouraged with the response made to the appeal of the Church towards the Century Fund, and the generosity shown in the large proportion assigned to the work of the Church at large. There has been in many cases real self-denial and the blessing will surely follow. There has been received in cash \$7,219.07; promises to pay, \$409.50; making a total of \$7,628.57, and as the time limit does not expire until the 1st of May, we are hopeful that \$8,000, the full sum aimed at, may yet be attained.

The thanks of the congregation are due and are hereby extended through the Session to all who have aided in the work of the congregation throughout the past year, the Board of Managers, and especially the Treasurer, the Sabbath School staff, those who lead us in the service of praise, the ushers, and all others who have helped to forward the interests of the congregation.

We look forward hopefully. Very great changes have taken place in the last decade of the congregation's history. A modern school-room is one of the necessities of the near future. Let us see to it that humbly and yet with abiding faith in God we undertake all responsibilities devolving upon us as a congregation, and may each individual honestly endeavor to bear his part. "Lord, lift Thou up the light of Thy countenance upon us."

## BOARD OF MANAGERS' REPORT.

---

Your Managers have pleasure in presenting to the congregation the report and statement of accounts in the usual form.

It will be seen from the figures submitted that the receipts have proved insufficient to meet the expenditure, the sum of deficiency being \$380.73, the falling off being principally in envelopes, which shows a shortage of \$388.18 beneath the envelope contributions of 1899.

Your Board of Managers entertain the hope that with an effort to do better in the future on the part of those who contribute only in name, and are able to do better, and those who give nothing toward the revenue fund, all current engagements will be met, and the adverse balance wiped out by the end of 1901.

The total moneys received from various sources throughout the year, including (in full) that of the Century Fund, but excepting missions and other societies' work, is \$13,071.22, which gives us great cause to thank God for his bountiful dealings with us throughout the year just closed.

After paying on mortgage (our percentage of the Century Fund so far contributed) \$1,065.00, our indebtedness on mortgage will be \$9,435.00, the mortgage now being \$10,500.00.

In conclusion, we rejoice with the congregation on such pleasing results, and most gratefully express our appreciation of the liberal and hearty response to the



call for the Century Fund, entertaining the hope that the amount aimed at, viz., \$8,000, will be on hand in time for the final remittance.

The retiring Managers are : R. K. Cowan, Walter Simson, Ed. E. Reid, W. J. Craig, Arch. McPherson, Wm. Tytler.

As Mr. Tytler has withdrawn from the congregation, the five first named only are eligible for re-election. Also one to fill the vacancy caused by the resignation of Mr. Templeton—7 members in all to be elected.

---

RECOMMENDATIONS FROM THE BOARD OF  
MANAGEMENT.

1. That an increase of \$100 per annum be added to Rev. W. J. Clark's salary.
2. That the sum of \$800 be placed to the credit of the Session for choir purposes.
3. That the constitution of the Church be amended so that adherents may be eligible to act as managers.
4. That \$100 be granted the Sunday School of the Church.
5. That the ushers now officiating be re-elected viz.: C. J. Riach, J. A. Sharp, J. M. Ferguson, F. Grant, J. Hynd, J. B. Aikenhead—with others added.

At the annual meeting the first of the above recommendations was dropped at the request of the Pastor, the second, fourth and fifth were sustained, and the third amended.

We have lost a number of very earnest and efficient teachers, Miss McIntosh and Mr. Wallace having gone to Toronto, Miss Christina Howie and Miss Munroe having regretfully given up their classes owing to ill-health, Miss Fleming having gone on a trip to Australia, and Dr. Hodge having been obliged, owing to

his professional duties, to give up his class of young men, who so thoroughly appreciated his abilities as a Bible Class leader. Four of these young men are now actively assisting in the work of the school. In the library Mr. David Smith retired after many years of careful and conscientious work, performed with unassuming unselfishness, and Mr. Will. Lawrence went into Mr. Clark's Bible Class.

But while we have suffered these losses we have been remarkably fortunate in securing such worthy successors as Mrs. Clark, Mrs. Leonard, Miss Kelso, Miss Bradshaw, Miss Hodge, Mr. Arthur Bryan, and Mr. Snelgrove. We have also been assisted very greatly by Mrs. J. N. Wood, Miss Short, Miss Phillips and other members of the Pastor's Bible Class, to whom our thanks are tendered.

Of the 52 whose names were removed from the roll of the school, 27 left the city, 10 went to other schools, 3 into the Pastor's class, 3 were removed by death, and 9 left for various reasons unknown to us.

We mourn the loss of three scholars through death: Leona Leonard, Isabel McDonald, and Isabel Clark. "Suffer the little children to come unto me, and forbid them not, for of such is the Kingdom of Heaven."

The School is now composed of 25 classes, including the Infant or Primary Class.

Although we cannot report any increase in numbers, the teachers and officers are by no means discouraged. The behavior of the scholars has been all that could be desired, and we believe that abiding impressions for good have been made on their minds and hearts. While the school building is not all that could be desired, the Managers have done their best to make the auditorium comfortable, and we hope that as soon as the opportune time comes an up-to-date school will be built.

We would urge two things especially on the parents or guardians of those under our charge. First—That children are sent regularly and punctually. It is too much to expect that the teachers can call every time that a scholar is absent to ascertain the cause.

If the parents do not take sufficient interest in their children's welfare to see that the children attend regularly, they can scarcely expect the teachers to give additional time for this purpose. Second—That the work of the teacher be supplemented by the parents, who can at least see to it that the lesson helps are carefully kept and carefully studied.

## MISSIONARY COMMITTEE.

---

The Missionary contributions for the year 1900 amounted to \$829.90, as against \$1,028.75 in 1899, but as the latter amount included a legacy of \$200 from the late Mr. Marshall, the actual amount collected was practically the same as last year.

The number of contributors is 146, nine less than last year, the average contributions having consequently increased from \$5.33 to \$5.63.

In 1898 the amount collected was \$948.50 by 201 contributors, so that both in numbers and amounts there has been a falling off during the past two years.

Last summer, at the request of Mr. H. M. Lay, a former member of Session, an organ previously used by the Sunday School, and valued at \$50, was sent out to White Horse. Largely through Mr. Lay's influence regular services have been established there, and the organ is highly appreciated, being used in leading the praise, thus making the meetings more attractive and enjoyable. This your Committee considered good Home Mission Work, and the amount required to pack and forward the organ to its destination (\$15.57) was defrayed out of the Mission Funds.

Your Committee regrets the falling off in Missionary contributions during the past two years. While thankfully admitting that many of our people give regularly and conscientiously for this purpose, it is no less true that others give only a little occasionally, or not at all. Let us hope, now that the strain of the



Century Fund is over, that an increasing number of our members and adherents will rise to a fuller appreciation of their duty and privilege in this matter, and do our share towards enabling the Presbyterian Church in Canada to carry out with some measure of efficiency the great work which has been laid upon her.

## AUXILIARY W. F. M. SOCIETY.

---

The year 1900 has shown a slight increase in the membership of the W. F. M. Auxiliary. The average attendance has been less than that of last year, and the general contributions have also been smaller; but since the special collections were of large proportion, it is felt that, financially, there has been no falling off in the spirit of giving. The work which has been undertaken by this Society is neither a small nor unimportant one, and the spirit in which it was performed has been one of willingness and cheerfulness; at the same time, it is felt that were the work distributed more generally among the members, it would tend towards the advancement of the Society, and would prove of more benefit individually.

Our membership is now 69. Eight meetings have been held during the year, with an average attendance of 36. The programmes of each month were well-prepared, being of a character to promote interest in Mission work. There has also been an effort to give a pleasant social spirit to the meetings, and all strangers are cordially welcomed.

The Thank-offering Meeting in October was well attended. The Rev. Mr. McGillivray was the lecturer of the evening, his thoughts being drawn from the text, "The sons of the stranger shall build up thy walls." The offering amounted to \$71.25, and was dedicated in prayer by the Rev. Mr. Clark. A good musical programme added to the pleasure of the evening, and refreshments were served by the Ladies' Aid Society. The Scattered Helpers' Association has contributed financially to the Auxiliary, the membership not being

as large as last year. An appeal to the Church was made by the Society in behalf of the India Famine Fund, and \$148.25 was collected, which has been forwarded through the proper channels.

The total contributions for the year amounted to \$158.12; expenses \$23.45. The balance of \$134.67 has been handed to the Presbyterial Treasurer. In addition to this, the box of clothing which was sent by the Society to the Northwest was valued at \$89.90.

It is urged that a larger number of the members should take a more active part in the work. If we attempt great things for God, we may expect great things from God.

## YOUNG WOMAN'S HOME MISSION CIRCLE.

It is with great pleasure that we place before the congregation our first Annual Report.

On Friday evening, March 30th, a meeting of the young women of the Church was called to consider the organization of a young women's missionary society. At this meeting it was decided to form a Home Mission Society and that it be known as the "Young Woman's Home Mission Circle of the First Presbyterian Church, London."

Our first regular meeting was held April 9th, when a membership of 51 was enrolled. Since then four regular meetings have been held, with an average attendance of 24.

In place of the June meeting a meeting of the Executive Committee was held, when a plan of work for the ensuing year was prepared. During the summer months our meetings were dropped, and resumed in September.

The thanks of the Society are due Miss Templeton and Messrs. Brown and Simpson, of this city, who so kindly aided us by giving a musical and literary recital in October.

Our Thank-offering meeting in November, which was addressed by our pastor, Mr. Clark, was decidedly interesting and the result gratifying, \$26.60 being the amount of the thank-offering of the members.

At our Annual Meeting the funds were allocated as follows: \$20 to the Klondike Nurses' Fund and \$20 to the Doukhobors; also the collection for the December meeting, amounting to \$4.65, was sent to the King's Daughters, to be used by them in aiding the poor of the city.

Before closing our report we wish to ask that the many young women in the congregation who have not yet joined us would take notice of our meetings. We would be pleased to welcome any of these as members of our circle. We ask only one hour on the second Thursday of each month and a membership fee of 25 cents a year. All other contributions are voluntary. We feel confident that those who join us will find the meetings both interesting and instructive and be well repaid for the small outlay of time and money.
