## C A P. CII.

An Act to revive and continue, until the First Day of *January* One thousand eight hundred and One, the Bounties granted by an Act, made in the Twenty-sixth Year of the Reign of His present Majesty, for encouraging the Fisheries carried on at *Newfoundland*, and Parts adjacent, from *Great Britain*, *Ireland*, and the *British Dominions in Europe*.

[12th July 1799.]

**W**HEREAS so much of an Act, made in the Twenty-sixth Year of the Reign of His present Majesty, intituled, *An Act to amend and render more effectual the several Laws now in Force for encouraging the Fisheries carried on at Newfoundland, and Parts adjacent, from Great Britain, Ireland, and the British Dominions in Europe, and for granting Bounties for a limited Time, on certain Terms and Conditions*, as relates to the Bounties thereby granted, which was to continue in Force for the Term of Ten Years, from the First Day of *January* One thousand seven hundred and eighty-seven, and which was revived, and further continued for Two Years, by an Act made in the Thirty-seventh Year of the Reign of His present Majesty, has been found useful and beneficial: And whereas it is expedient, That so much of the said Act

The Bounties granted by the recited Act shall, from Jan. 1, 1799, be revived, and continue in Force for Two Years from that Day.

as relates to the Bounties thereby granted, should be revived, and further continued; be it therefore enacted by the King's most Excellent Majesty, by and with the Advice and Consent of the Lords Spiritual and Temporal, and Commons, in this present Parliament assembled, and by the Authority of the same, That the Bounties granted by the said recited Act, and all and every Regulation therein contained respecting the same, shall, from and after the First Day of *January* One thousand seven hundred and ninety-nine, be revived, and the same are hereby revived; and the said Bounties shall be paid and allowed, and the said Regulations shall continue in Force for and during the further Term of Two Years from the said First Day of *January* One thousand seven hundred and ninety-nine.
