PITTSBURGH, Dec. 26.—Frank A. Aldrich of Stamford, Kansas, was on Nov. 23, 1889, sentenced to serve seven years and six months in the Western Penitentiary for bumping J. R. Lemon, a wealthy resident of Allegheny, out of \$10,000.

Aldrich is a man of not the best reputation, but evidence was presented to the Pardons Board which satisfied that body that he had been unjustly convicted.

So convincing was this evidence that when it was laid before Lemon he confessed he had been deceived by the detectives and joined in signing the petition for the pardon.


