CURRENT TRADE CONDITIONS.

ONTARIO.

It might be regarded as misleading to state that the lumber trade of Ontario is experiencing a boom, yet the movement of lumber during the past week has been of such volume as to cause manufacturers and dealers to feel well satisfied. The most activity, of course, is confined to the pine trade, in which branch heavy shipments are being made to the United States, while the local consumption has been quite large. In many of the towns extensive building operations are under way; for instance, in Sault Ste. Marie the Lake Superior Power Company are about to commence the construction of fifty double houses. The shipment of lumber from Georgian Bay mill points is very active, and a fair summer and good fall trade is looked for. The stock lists sent out by manufacturers on the 1st of June show no decline in prices, but on the other hand a slight advance in some grades. The possibility that the carpenters of Ottawa may continue their strike has somewhat unsettled the trade in that district, but it is thought that matters will be amicably arranged before there has been much interference to building operations. Nothing new can be said of hardwoods, which continue to be purchased in a hand-to-mouth manner.

QUEBEC AND NEW BRUNSWICK.

Notwithstanding the backward demand from Great Britain, the spruce lumber market is reasonably active, as the shipments to the United States, France, Aus-

tralia, and the West Indies have been rather above the average in quantity. A number of vessels are under charter to load for South America. Reports from Quebec tell of a stronger market for square and waney pine timber. There is still some uncertainty as to the outcome of the log drives in New Brunswick, information received a few days ago going to show that about 50,000,000 feet may be hung up in the head-waters of the St. John. Logs are changing hands at \$9 per thousand feet. Clapboards are firmer, from \$31 to \$32 being asked for extra quality on Boston rate of freight.

UNITED STATES.

The white pine situation in the United States is decidedly strong. The total shipments of lumber from Minneapolis up to June 1 of this year was 172,000,000 feet, a gain of 16,000,000 feet over the same period one year ago. There are rumors that the interior mill men in Wisconsin and Minnesota will shortly make a further advance in the prices of some grades, which continue scarce in spite of the heavy production. A feature of strength has been the action of the Chicago lumber trade in marking up prices. Common stock boards, 8, 10 and 12 in., were advanced 50 cents; No. 2 13 in. box boards one dollar; No. 2 A cedar shingles from \$2.60 to \$2.65; and No. 1 and mixed lath 10 cents. At Saginaw dry stock in large blocks is scarce and dealers are anxious to purchase. Fine common is about \$1 higher per thousand than one month ago. Buffalo and Tonawanda dealers report an exceptionally good trade. There is a tendency to advance prices on the lower grades, including 12 inch boards and No. 3 barn, of which the stock is very light. In the east building is progressing favorably, with a strengthening effect on spruce. There is little possibility that prices of this lumber will be materially lower this season. The continued good crop reports has created an improved demand for hardwoods from the implement manufacturers, but the movement is still light. Ash is showing an improvement, with maple and elm steady. Basswood is being bought quite liberally.

Receipts of laths at eastern distributing points have been on a larger scale of late, but owing to its being almost entirely out of the market, it will be some time before it is plentiful again. Prices, however, are not expected to further advance. Shingles are strong and meet with ready sale.

GREAT BRITAIN.

The quantity of timber which has arrived in Great Britain since the opening of the shipping season has been a surprise to

the trade. It was thought that the first-open-water shipments would be very light, but the quantity has been almost equal to last year. Predictions are now made that the summer receipts will show a marked falling off, and it remains to be seen whether this condition will be experienced. It is quite certain that the market is not in a position to receive heavy consignments of lumber, but if shipments are limited it is probable that the market will soon recover lost ground, and the foundation would be laid for a large trade next year. Lumber now arriving has mostly been purchased at such a price as to make it almost impossible to dispose of it at a reasonable profit. Importers in a position to do so will no doubt hold the stock until there is an improvement in the market. While at London and Liverpool the stock of Quebec lumber is heavy, the supply at Glasgow and at some other ports is not excessive nor more than is usual at this season of the year. Spruce deals have shown no improvement, sales being difficult to make.

STOCKS AND PRICES.

In the Saginaw Valley log run pine is quoted at \$18 to \$24, box lumber at \$16, and mill culls at \$12 and \$12.50.

The Skillings, Whitney & Barnes Company, of Ogdensburg, N. Y., are reported to have made heavy purchases of lumber in the Georgian Bay district.

On May 25th the first cargo of lumber was shipped from Ashland, Wis., to England. It consisted of 500,000 feet of Norway deals. This is the fifth consignment of lumber from Ashland to Canada this year, and the first to be consigned directly to England.

About 4,000,000 feet of logs are expected to be rafted from Ontario to Michigan this season, the timber being cut on Indian reserve lands.

The Eddy-Sheldon Company, of Bay City, Mich., recently received two cargoes of lumber, totalling about 1,000,000 feet, from Algoma Mills, Ont.

The steamer Berax is loading a cargo of deals at Montreal for the United Kingdom, shipped by J. Burstall Company.

The steamer Feronia is loading deals at Montreal for the United Kingdom for Dobell, Bickitt & Company, and the str. Audoni is expected in Montreal shortly to load a cargo of deals for London.

The schooner Frank Simson is loading deals at St. John, N. B., for the United Kingdom.

The steamer Dunmore Head is loading

a cargo of deals at Batiscan, Que., for Cork, Ireland.

N. & A. Dymont, of Thessalon, Ont., are supplying a quantity of pine timber for bridges along the line of the Algoma Central Railway.

The barque Seguin has taken two cargoes of lumber from Parry Sound to Buffalo since the season opened, the shippers being the Parry Sound Lumber Company.

Last week Robert Aiken had 10,000,000 feet of logs out of the Aroostook river into the corporation limits above Grand Falls, N. B., but the water was low and the logs are in danger of being hung up.

The drives owned by S. H. DeCew and J. A. Lindsay, of Fenelon Falls, Ont., which were hung up on Union Creek, a tributary of the Burnt river, are now moving, recent rains having been of great benefit.

Of the Barbadoes lumber market Messrs. S.P. Musson, Son & Company say: The arrivals of white pine and spruce have been the "Bravo", from Lunenburg, N.S., with 140,000 feet spruce; Jessie L. Smith, from Bridgewater, N.S., with 15,000 feet shipping and 16,000 feet second quality white pine, 47,000 feet shipping spruce, 8,000 feet dressed boards, and 21,000 feet scantling; and the Arctic, from Bridgewater, N.S., with 7,000 feet shipping and 20,000 feet second quality white pine, 20,000 feet shipping and 8,000 feet second quality spruce, and 48,000 feet scantling. The cargo of the Bravo was placed at \$17.50, and that of the Arctic at \$25.75 for shipping and \$20 for second quality white pine, \$17.05 for shipping and \$13 second quality spruce, and \$13 for shipping and \$11 for second quality scantling. White pine is wanted and would bring fair prices, but there is an ample supply of spruce.

THE BOSTON MARKET.

The spruce lumber market in Boston is very firm. Orders are reported that cannot be filled from yard stock, and few mills are sawing. It is understood that at Bangor, Me., some of the mills have run out of logs, a feature alone which is sufficient to keep the market strong. The demand for lumber is light, but the supply is unusually small. The quotations are: 10 and 12 inch dimensions, \$18 to \$19.50; 9 inch and under, \$17 to \$18; 10 and 12 inch random lengths, 10 ft. and up, \$17.50 to \$18.50; 2x3 to 2x7, and 3x4, 10 feet and up, \$15 to \$16; all other randoms, 9 inch and under, 10 feet and up, \$15.50 to \$17; 5 inch and up merchantable boards, \$15 to \$16; matched boards, \$17 to \$18; out spruce boards, \$12.50; bundle furring, \$14.

The market for hemlock lumber holds firm, with extremely small offerings, and western pine is very strong. One inch uppers are quoted at \$58 to \$62; 1 1/4 to 2 inch, \$63 to \$64; fine common, 1 to 3 inch, \$45 to \$60; sheathings, \$38 to \$54; barn boards, \$25 to \$30; coffin boards, \$23 to \$25.

Shingles are very firm; while the demand is not active, some sellers find difficulty in filling orders. Considerable trouble has been experienced with the New Brunswick manufacturers in securing their logs, and the supply is likely to be small: Extra cedar, \$2.85 to \$2.90; clear, \$2.60; second clear, \$2 to \$2.25; clear sap, \$2 to \$2.25; extra, No. 1, \$1.60 to \$1.75; Washington and British Columbia, 16-inch, five butts to two inches, \$3.15 to \$3.25.

Clapboards hold firm, with some sellers asking as high as \$32 for extra: Extra spruce, \$30 to \$32; clear \$28 to \$29; second clear, \$25 to \$26; pine, extra, \$36 to \$38; clear, \$36 to \$37; second clear, \$28 to \$30; California redwood, clear, \$42.50 to \$45; second grade, \$40 to \$42.

Laths show a little more firmness. The quotations are: 1 1/8 inch, \$2.85 to \$2.90; 1 1/2 inch, \$2.70 to \$2.85.

A fire broke out in the lumber yard of the Conger Lumber Company at Parry Sound, on June 6th, destroying the docks, tramways and several million feet of lumber. The greater part of the lumber was owned by the Skillings, Whitney & Barnes Company, of Ogdensburg, N. Y. The loss is estimated at \$80,000.

ST. JOHN WINTER SHIPMENTS.

According to a statement compiled by the St. John Board of Trade, the deal and timber shipments by the winter port steamers in the season of 1900-1901 were 14 1/2 per cent. greater than in the previous season. The total shipments were 16,649 standards of deals and 2,904 loads of timber, made up as follows.

Elder-Dempster line to Liverpool—6,250 stds. deals and 3,037 loads timber. Manchester line to Manchester—5,022 stds. deals and no timber.

Furness line to London—824 stds., deals and 303 loads timber.

Donaldson line to Glasgow—2,226 stds. deals and 563 loads timber.

Head line to Belfast and Dublin—3,327 stds. deals and 101 loads timber.

Compared with the figures for the pre-

ceding winter, there was an increase of 2,123 standards of deals and 803 loads of timber.

The schooner Corsicande recently arrived at Sarnia from the Algoma district, with 300,000 feet of lumber for F. McGibbon & Sons.

The saw mill and planing mill of James Brown, at Acton, Ont., were burned last week. The loss is \$6,000, and the insurance \$2,000.

The Timber Trades Journal reports the charter of a steamer from the St. Lawrence to Aberdeen, deals, 514, 3d, timber 759, and one from St. John, N.S., to Limerick, 429, 6d, June sailing.

The brig. James Daly, has been chartered by Harlow & Kempton, to load lumber at Liverpool, N.S., for the West Indies. The brig. Blenheim will load a cargo of lumber at Quebec, for Malta, Mediterranean.
