A MUSKETRY TRAINING SCHOOL Established and Rifle Clubs Will Be Assisted. Says Dr. Borden at D.R.A. Annual Meeting.

Ottawa, Feb. 27.—Hon. J. M. Gibson presided at the 33rd annual meeting of the Dominion Rifle Association, held in the Dominion House, Ottawa, on Wednesday evening last.
