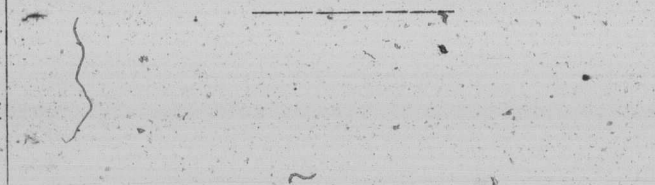

FROM ALL SOURCES.

Munkasy's picture of Milton and his daughters, which figured at the Paris exhibition, has been sold at Vienna for \$40,000. The alleged outbreak of leprosy in the Spanish province of Alicante is said to consist of hereditary cases, and to be not contagious. Count Bela Stecheny, who proposes to search out the original seats of the Magyars in central Asia, has been furnished with a Chinese passport enabling him to travel in Tibet. The cooks in Paris are going over to the republic if it be true, as is reported, that the Duchesse de Nemours' cook has deserted to M. Gambetta and Baron Gustave Rothschild's cook to President Frey. There has been a remarkable case of constancy in England. A man who separated from his wife thirty-five years ago, has just returned and offered to "kiss and make up." A few days prior to the offer the wife had inherited a large estate. The ceremony of baptism by immersion was celebrated in western Texas the other day, and when the fourteen candidates walked down to the water fifteen revolvers were deposited on the bank of the stream, that of the preacher making the fifteenth. The numbers of fires that took place in Paris during the past year was 2,734. Twenty of them were caused by accident, 2,800 by imprudence or negligence, and 200 by defects of buildings. The approximate damage done by these fires is estimated at about \$835,000. The medical faculty of the university of Zurich have conferred the degree of doctor on Fraulein Draya Spicic, a young lady from Servia, and Countess Vilna Hugonai, of Hungary, both of whom passed successful examinations and delivered inaugural dissertations of exceptional merit. The Revolution Francaise has been fined 2,000 francs for printing articles by the escaped political convicts, Jules Valles and Arthur Arnould, the substance of the articles were not given. The sole offence charged was in violation of a decree of 1852, prohibiting the publication of writings by persons under sentence for certain crimes. The usual number of men employed to clean the streets of Berlin is 700. But during the month of January it was necessary to supplement the regular staff by a corps of 1,400 assistants in order to clear away the snow. During January over 100,000 cart loads of snow were carried away, and yet a great number of streets remained impassable. A man who ran a clairvoyance business and a faro game in Fortville, Ind., was mobbed by his fellow townsmen who broke all the windows of his house with stones, and drove him out of the place. There were other fortune tellers in Fortville, and other professional gamblers, none of whom were molested, but for one man to combine the two callings was more than the people would stand. The Dresden academy for the teaching of tailoring and dressmaking was attended last year by 264 pupils, male and female. Of these 187 followed the class for the cutting of women's dresses, 99 that for the cutting of men's linen, and 95 that for arithmetic and bookkeeping. Among the foreign pupils there are natives of Belgium, Denmark, Holland, Russia, Sweden and Norway, Switzerland, Austria and North America. Snuggling on the Swiss Italian frontier has taken a new development. The Italian customs regulations permit the entry, duty free, of small quantities of petroleum, coffee and sugar, and as the border can be crossed many times a day, an enormous traffic is going on in these articles, which the frontier guards are unable to prevent, inasmuch as those engaged in it are careful never to take in one journey more than the maximum quantity allowed by the Italian law. Nothing can exceed the popularity of the German Emperor. He not only enters any theatre without the audience rising to their feet to hurrah and chant the national hymn; and such is the ceaseless stream of gifts kept pouring into the palace by his attentive subjects, that the aged monarch has at last been compelled to limit the public of a half-forgotten order in council forbidding the presentation of books, music, objects of art and industry, etc., without leave being previously asked for and obtained. The widow and executor of M. Thiers having come to the conclusion that the publication of his political speeches would prove a monument to his memory, lost no time in settling about it, and the first three volumes will soon be published. They are prepared by a political essay from the pen of Senator Calmon, giving an interesting outline of his remarkable career, which, however, is necessarily tinged by party bias, and is not likely to meet with general acceptance. The speeches about to be published extend from 1830 to 1836. From recent statistics it appears that there are no fewer than 1,100 daily, weekly, and monthly journals published in the French capital. Of these, 71 are devoted to religion, 104 to jurisprudence and administration, 153 to commerce and finance, 25 to geography and history, 159 to recreation, 35 to instruction, 40 to literature and philology, 18 to fine arts, 4 to photography, 8 to architecture, 15 to music, 17 to the stage, 70 to fashions, 134 to industry, 80 to medicine, 48 to science, 29 to the army and navy, 38 to agriculture, and 23 to sport. The number of daily papers published in Paris is 19, and political reviews, 17. In examining a large collection of African fossils, obtained by Mr. P. Bain, and forwarded by him to the British Museum, Prof. Owen has recently found a few water-worn fragments of bone which indicate a low Theriodont reptile new to science. For this creature he proposes the name Titanocheilus from a name suggestive at once of its great size and of its tenacity. These characteristics are inferred from the nature of the teeth. Possibly it found its prey in such creatures as the porcupine, the marmosets, and the tapinocephalus, which existed in the same geological period and in the same area. The new genus is founded on the most perfect fragments of bone. John Goodrich's constant companion, in Hartford, was a fine setter dog, and the attachment toward them was very strong. They went hunting for muskrats, a few weeks ago, and toward night the dog returned alone. He was wet and muddy, and acted in a strangely excited manner, running to and fro as though to attract attention. He led the way to a creek, where Goodrich's body was found. The master and fallen into the water in a fit, and the dog after trying in vain to pull him out, had run home for assistance. The dog would not do anything after the burial of his master, from whose hands alone he had been accustomed to receive food, and for whom his grief was apparently excessive. Circular Letter from His Lordship Bishop Grinnon to the Catholic Societies of the Diocese of Hamilton. GENTLEMEN,—The national feast of Ireland's patron Saint is near at hand, and Irishmen and their descendants rejoice at this event all the world over, for their lot is cast in all nations. The conversion of Ireland from Paganism to Christianity is the most remarkable event in ecclesiastical history. St. Patrick was sent to our nation by Pope St. Celestine in the year 432, and during his missionary life he had the great consolation to see the entire nation converted to christianity, and that without the shedding of a drop of human blood. This is an event unparalleled in the history of christianity, and speaks eloquently for the advanced state of civilization among the Pagan Irish. When their priests and learned men heard the apostle preaching the new doctrine, they argued with him, but when convinced they embraced the Christian faith. And so complete was the conversion that the nation in a short time became an "island of saints and scholars." The country was dotted over with churches, monasteries and colleges which were filled to overflowing—as Montalambert, the great French historian and statesman, asserts that the college alone contained more than 3,000 students. From these seats of learning thousands of missionaries went forth to convert the nations afar. St. Columba, with twelve disciples, went over to Scotland and converted that nation and a great part of England. St. Columbanus, accompanied by twelve followers, went to France, which the same historian says was then half Christian and half Pagan. There they built their monasteries from which they went forth to preach to the people, and after years of successful labor some of them passed into Switzerland, Germany, Holland, and even to Italy, and in all these countries tens of thousands were converted, and magnificent churches and colleges were erected, which, for many ages, were the great centres of learning and civilization; and to the present they bear the names of these Irish saints and contain their sacred relics. In their own island home colleges and monasteries were opened to vast numbers of the youth of Europe, who flocked thither for education, and the venerable Bede, the English historian, tells us that they were all received and educated gratuitously. This happy state of things continued for some ages, after which there came a sad change, over which I wish to draw a veil. Now, gentlemen, the feast of St. Patrick brings to our mind these glorious memories of yore, and I hope the day will never come when Irishmen or their children will neglect to commemorate these glorious events of our past history. I consider it our duty to celebrate this festival in a religious manner by attending at holy mass in the forenoon and hearing a concert of music in the afternoon, the proceeds of which I have decidedly opposed to street parades, for I cannot see what practical good can arise from them. Walking the streets, carrying flags, and beating of drums cannot make us better Catholics or true Irishmen. But living in a mixed community they are a continual source of irritation to others, and in this lies the evil. By abstaining from all such parades you will have the approbation of all well disposed men, and let us hope that your example will be followed by others in the course of time, so that Irishmen may become united in building up this free and happy country; then you will enjoy what they do not at present, full representation in the government of the country. Let us take the advice of our distinguished countryman, the late Governor-General, and avoid imparting to this country—unnecessary as it is by any record of civil strife; a stain of blood, fresh and bright from the hands of its Maker, which all have been freely admitted upon equal terms—the blood-thirsty strife and brutal quarrels of the old World.
