

## CONSTITUTION.

## ARTICLE I.

NAME.

The Club shall be called The Montreal Pionees Freethought Club.

## ARTICLE II.

#### ARTICLE III.

#### MEMBERSHIP.

### ARTICLE IV.

#### OFFICERS.

The Officers of the club shall be a President, three Vice-Presidents, Recording and Financial Secretaries, a Treasurer, a Librarian and seven Directors, who together shall form a general committee of management. The foregoing constitution may be amended by a two-thirds vote of any meeting, but notice of motion for such amendment must be given at least four weeks previous to the discussion of same, of which notice the Secretary shall duly inform every member.

Three weeks shall he limit of time allowed for reading each volume, any member failing to return a book after this time be fined for each week of its detention the sum of ents, and shall not be allowed the use of the Liy until such fine be paid. Any member who may have finished the perusal of any volume within the ified time may retain the same for one week longer otifying the Librarian, provided that no other memhas applied for the book.

3. If any member lose or injure a book, he or she l replace the same, or if analyle to do so, pay the e thereof, and if the book belong to a set, shall ree the set of pay the value the cof.

4. The Librarian shall call in all books two wee previous to the annual meeting. They shall be careful examined and checked by a committee of three appoint by the President for that purpose. The Librarian shamake an Annual Report stating the circulation, to general condition of the Books, number missing if an amount of fines received, etc., during the year.

5. The privileges of the Library shall be grant to no member in arrears; and the Financial Secreta shall make monthly a list of all members not in arrear for the guidance of the Librarian who shall delive books only to those whose names appear on it.
