Big Mining Improvement

B.C. Copper Co. to Undertake Expenditures of One Hundred Thousand Dollars. The British Columbia Copper Company, Limited, operating a big smelter plant at Greenwood, the Mother Lode mine in Summit camp, and the Boundary district, the Asarco group at Apex group, near Keremeos, and the Sunset mine, on Copper Mountain in the Myers Creek camp, has announced a programme of enlargements and betterments at both the smelter and Mother Lode mine which will involve in the aggregate the expenditure of fully \$100,000.

Additional Electrical Equipment. The British Columbia Copper Company has recently been let to the Power & Mining Machinery Company for the building of three blast furnaces 36x40 inches, which will be the largest ever built in Canada. They will have a combined capacity of 1,800 tons of material, and will be charged from side-dumping cars hauled by trolley locomotives.
