AUSTRIAN SAILORS RELEASED. Evidence Was Not Strong Enough to Warrant Their Detention. Havre, France, July 26.—In accordance with the orders of the public prosecutor, the six Austrian sailors of the wrecked French line steamer La Bourgogne, who were charged with cruelly brutality to passengers at the time of the collision on July 4, between the steamer and British ship Comarantshof, off Sable Island, Nova Scotia, resulting in the loss of over 500 lives, through the sinking of La Bourgogne, were liberated to-day and their prosecution was dropped, owing to lack of evidence

Some Curious Developments in the Case of Vancouver's Ex-Mayor. He Was Drowned in a Klondike Steam Last Year, and a Body Supposed to Be His Was Sent Home—Now There Is Doubt as to Whether It Was His Body

Vancouver, B.C., July 26.—(Special.)—When the body of ex-Mayor Fred Cope of Vancouver was buried yesterday, friends and relatives said, "And now we have heard the latest of poor Fred." But this was not to be. Vancouver's late chief magistrate was drowned in a Klondike steamer nearly a year ago. The news was a terrible shock to the city. There was much newspaper talk about insurance money and the impossibility of finding the body. Only last month a man named Simpson, who had been identified as the body, was taken to the station and handed over to Komp & Simpson, rival undertakers. The body was not opened, in the hurry, and the body was therefore buried without being identified here. An investigation will be held, and the body no doubt exhumed at Vancouver. This court, consisting of five judges, on Sept. 21, 1897, unanimously reversed the decision of the Superior Court, England's motion and gave judgment in favor of the defendants, on the ground, in effect, that Dr. England had failed to show that his defendants were guilty of any fault in law toward him, or that they were responsible to him in the circumstances

Charles Baker Tries to Board Car and Falls Under Trailer. London, Oct. 27.—(Special.)—Charles Baker, 22 years old, tried to board a car at Springham, missed his footing and fell under the wheel of the trailer. The calf of his right leg was broken, and the left leg broken in two places. His head also was severely injured, and his recovery is doubtful. He was removed to his home, 29 Pipe Line-road, South London

The last load of hay was going in just when the lightning struck, and nothing could be moved. Mr. Cramer's loss will be heavy; no insurance

NATIONAL CONFERENCE

To Be Held at Saratoga Springs

August 19 and 20 to discuss Future Foreign Policy.

Chicago, July 26.—The Civic Federation of Chicago to-night gave out a call for a national conference, to be held at Saratoga Springs, N.Y., August 19 and 20.

The undersigned deem it desirable that a national conference be convened at an early date to consider the future foreign policy of the United States.

The war with Spain gives promise of the growth of Spanish power in Cuba, Porto Rico, Philippines and elsewhere.

The question of what disposition the United States should make of these possessions when peace is reached is one too soon in engaging the thought of our people.

This question impresses us as being one of the most serious the American people have had to consider.

It is a new question and one upon which heretofore very little thought has been given by the great majority of the people.

Whether the foreign policy of the United States should be adhered to or departed from is enough to challenge the most serious consideration of our ablest and most thoughtful men.

In our opinion this conference should be composed of men from all parts of the country, without regard to political affiliation and irrespective of whether they are for or against a policy of territorial expansion.

The circular letters sent out by Chairman Henry Wade Rogers and Secretary Ralph P. Carter, asking for signatures, stated that neither the general character of the war would be discussed nor any political act be given the proceedings.

The signers embrace Governors, Mayors, Presidents of the Trade, presidents of colleges, lawyers, presidents of banks, labor leaders, leading clergymen and manufacturers.

Only individual names were asked for, a great many organizations authorized their presidents to sign officially.
