POPULATION OF JAILS SHOWS LARGE INCREASE

Annual Report of Inspector of Prisons Presented to the Legislature.

The thirty-sixth annual report of Dr. Chamberlain, Inspector of Prisons, was laid on the table of the legislature yesterday.

The number of committals in 1903 was 5281, nearly 1000 in excess of the previous year.

The cost of maintaining the jails in the province for food, clothing and fuel was \$1,232,844 for salaries, \$260,913, and for ordinary repairs \$122,223.

It is worthy of note that all the jails of the province in their returns of the earnings of prisoners only report \$32,59 as the total earnings of prisoners for the year.

The report for the Central Prison shows 715 committals. There were 303 in custody at the commencement of the year, making the total 1018, compared with 1019 the previous year.

There were committed for vagrancy 201, as compared with 140 the previous year. The number discharged on tickets-of-release was 84, and 18 were discharged on remission of sentence.

In the Reformatory for Boys the number of inmates at the beginning of the year was 112, committed 44. Thirtysix were pardoned, 15 transferred to the Central Prison, three escaped and 56 were in residence at the close of the year.

The Mercer Reformatory for Females received 111 guests, as compared with 117 the year before. The average population during the year, the average population of reformatory and refuge was 132, as against 141 the preceding year.
