RESOLUTION OF COMMITTEE.

"That the Secretary shall, previously to each Quarterly Meeting, prepare a tabular view of the numerical and financial state of the Mission; also a synoptical statement of the business to be done. And in order to do this, Missions shall hold their quarterly meetings sufficiently early to enable them to have their reports to the Mission Office not less than one week previously to the meeting of the Committee; and in case any of the Missionaries shall fail in doing so, their reports shall not be read, nor their grants sent until the succeeding meeting. The Committee earnestly hope that all the brethren will assist in enabling the Secretary to carry out the above arrangement, so that they may have time to discuss what really pertains to the Mission work.

The Quarterly Meeting of these Committees shall be held in Toronto, on Thursday, the 15th of August, and Thursday the 7th of November, 1878; on Thursday the 6th of February, and Thursday the 1st of May, 1879. Each Meeting to commence at nine o'clock A.M.

We feel it our duty to state that the number of our members largely augments every year, the suitable field for our work, it would be increased in number, and the building of church edifices and other accommodations for the engaged.

There are now 1000 members in the fields; and the number of 187 Class-Listed, 21 Persons in Sabbath Schools.

The increase in the number of members was 228, in the year 1878. They are principally from the United States, yet an excellent class. There are 300 Scholars 3000 in souls received into the church by baptism. God and grace be with us.

REPORT.

To the Friends and Supports of the Primitive Methodist Missions in Canada.

DEAR FRIENDS :—It is our agreeable duty to present to you once more the Annual Report of our Mission Fund and Mission Work. We have toiled through another year, and, under the blessing of God, have obtained an encouraging measure of success. It has been the highest pleasure for us to publish the glorious Gospel of Jesus Christ, and proclaim Him to men as their all-sufficient Saviour. We have no other gospel.

We feel thankful that we are enabled to report progress, and may state that there is strong reason to believe that this progress would be largely augmented were there ampler means at our command. Besides the suitable maintenance of the Agents who are engaged in Mission work, it would indeed be well if many others could be added to their number, and if we had money wherewith to aid in the erection of some church edifices, in important centres of population, to afford needful accommodation, and give prestige to the good work in which we are engaged.

There are fifty-three Missionaries in active employment on our mission fields ; and on those missions are 4043 Members, 128 Local Preachers, 187 Class-leaders, 118 Connexional Churches, 71 other preaching places, 21 Parsonages, 74 Sabbath Schools, 575 S. School Teachers, and 3978 Sabbath Scholars.

The increase of Church Members for the year on the Mission Stations was 228, notwithstanding the net loss of more than 500 by removals—principally to localities where the Primitive Methodist Church has not yet an existence—increase of Sabbath Schools 11, Teachers 55, and Scholars 330 ; while the moral and spiritual results of this mission work in souls renewed and sins forgiven, and in the young being trained for God and goodness, can only be known in the great hereafter.

In connection with the operations of this Society, there have been, and still are, great difficulties to encounter; one of which is loss of members and Christian workers, by removals to parts of the country beyond the pale of our Church. Hundreds are converted from their ungodliness, and brought to a knowledge of saving truth as it is in Jesus, through the labors of our agents, who migrate from the places and scenes associated with their early Christian life, and become lost to the denomination to whose agency they, under God, owe their conversion. The Day of God, however, will reveal the product of all our efforts to do good and save men.

It will be seen from the following brief financial statement for the past year, that there is great need for our missionary income to be largely augmented; and it is earnestly hoped such will be the case.

It is a matter of deep regret that the Society's expenditure in the past year has surpassed its income to the amount of \$924 78. We kindly but earnestly say to one and all—ministers, contributors, and collectors—Resolve, in God's name, that additional enthusiasm and liberality shall be infused into our missionary interests this year. The necessities and claims of the Society are such that we are constrained to call on all our ministers and friends to *form zealous purpose*, that the Missionary Anniversaries of the present year shall be specially effective and productive. To retrograde, or even rest in a stationary, unprogressive condition, is inglorious, when there is so much to be done for the success of the Church, the honor of God, and the salvation of men.

What more can we do to accomplish advancement? Every thing for God and the world's good *must* have advancement. New impulses must be given, and new energies and resources called into requisition, to rise above a mere stationary state, and attain progress. This should be a fact connected with every good cause, but especially the missionary enterprise. Let our missionary platforms be characterized by a *powerful and effective advocacy* of the missionary question, that a potent impetus

may be given to the missionary spirit of the Church ; let ministers see strictly to the appointment of active missionary collectors every where ; let the *children of our Sabbath Schools* be enlisted in missionary giving and collecting ; and we kindly ask the collectors to go their rounds *with zeal and in good time*, not confining their operations to the members of the Church, but appealing to the public. Those of the public who are outside the Church owe much to the Gospel, and should be called on to support its propagation.

The idea is afloat that missionary contributions on a station militate against the ordinary income for local purposes. It is a *sad mistake* to narrow down the benevolence of the people to one or two schemes of the Church. Ordinary contributions are likely to receive a new impulse from the spirit of liberality which general enterprise, such as the missionary cause, awakens. Let the missionary and other kindred undertakings have their full sway among a people, and they will be brought to feel more the duty of taking part in any necessary object for local prosperity.

Could not most of our Circuits increase their missionary revenue fifty per cent? It is thought they could, and no one be hurt. Yes, half as much again might come from some stations and localities than has been wont to be sent of late. There are individuals who give *liberally* to the Mission Fund; but are there not hundreds in our Societies and Congregations who might contribute twenty, fifteen, ten, and five dollars, instead of one, on behalf of mission work? No person of considerable worldly means should count it enough to contribute one or two dollars in twelve months to the missionary cause. Let all ask how much we owe our Lord and Master.

Our Canadian work continues to receive liberal sympathy from the parent body in England. But while this monetary help is rendered from Britain, we ought not on that account to do the less for ourselves. Foreign aid may possibly prove more or less paralysing to noble self-reliance and self-effort on the part of those who are the recipients of it. Let us not allow this to be truthfully said of the Primitive Methodists of Canada.

The cause of Missions is being vigorously sustained by our people in the old country. They have numerous Home Missions, some of which are conducted with uncommon enterprise and labor, of which the following is a noble specimen :—

ANNUAL REPORT.

"BRIGHTON.—London-road is all we could desire; it alone will entirely keep a man after this quarter. £1250 have been paid off the chapel in the six months past. Haywards Heath will itself keep another next quarter; so that the Brighton Second that was, will be able to keep two men eighteen months after opening, and will have £3000 worth of chapel property, with £900 debt entire. This is work and success unparalleled in our missioning. Lewes and Newhaven should soon become a new station. But you will see, with £12,000 worth in hand in the town of Brighton and £1000 at Haywards Heath, and thirty miles of country to travel about and watch over and work, it is a little too much to take up Lewes and Newhaven. But the 'Field white to harvest' ought to be taken. Yesterday, in villages and town, I travelled ninety miles in my station; struck a good stroke, with Benjamin with me, for taking a village seven miles from Horsham, where there is no religious effort put forth. A lady there, a friend of Benjamin, will give £30 towards starting a young man at once to mission; and her brother promised to wait upon the Lord of the Manor to secure, free of cost, a site for a chapel if we will come at once. This gentleman, a farmer, said to me he would welcome anybody, even a 'Roman Catholic, if he would come; for a minister he had never seen in his house all the years he had lived in it.' I went to Horsham, where a place has been offered me at once to commence work in. This Horsham, and the villages 25 miles away from me, and 32 miles, are too much for me to reach; but God will help me.—W. DINNICK."

We here give a brief extract of part of the *African Mission*:—

"ST. ISABEL, WEST AFRICA.—On the whole, our mission is in a pleasing condition. Alas! we have now and then to mourn over backsliding; but, in spite of these, there is much to encourage us. At Santa Isabel our congregations are large, and the classes well attended."

"GEORGE'S BAY.—It is not my province to report on this mission, but it is only an act of justice to refer to the good condition of that mission. I have been to the Bay twice, and both times was delighted with what I saw. Bro. Parr spares no toil or pains to make his mission a success. He 'is pegging' away at the language, and, if spared, will get it into something like order. Already many hymns are translated; and the children and youths join with 'Primitive' vigor in singing them. Oh! my heart leaped with joy when I heard them singing in their own tongue, translations of 'Jesus loves me, this I know,' 'Jesus, the name high over all,' and several others. The work of brother Maylott was purely foundation work; that of his successors consists in rearing up what shall one day prove a blessing to the district, an honour to the Connexion, and bring Glory to our Saviour. Of the men who have toiled there, any body of Christians might well feel proud. My impression is that brother and sister Maylott did not get credit done them for the hard and unseen pioneering work they accomplished. On October 24, Mr Parr and I visited a bubo town about mid-way from here to George's Bay, with a view to missioning it. We were kindly received, and think it probable that the people would gladly receive a missionary.—R. W. BURNETT."

In conclusion, we would commend the cause of our missions to the sympathy, prayers, and liberal aid of all church members and friends. Let us, every one, do and dare for God, and when life's toils and duties are ended, may the recompense of the just and the faithful be ours.
