Additional Proof of the Honest Desire of the Provincial Government to See a Railway Built in the St. John Valley Without Further Delay.

Minister of Public Works Has Not Replied to Hon. J. K. Flemming, on Matter of Subsidy for Line, and Mr. Flemming Writes Again, Conceding Pugsley's Request, and Asking for Conference.

Realizing the importance of the Valley Railway project and receiving no reply from Hon. William Pugsley, with reference to the Dominion subsidy, Hon. J. K. Flemming, Acting Premier of the Province, has written to the Minister of Public Works again, urging the advantages of the through line across Maine to Quebec, but offering, in the event of Mr. Pugsley's final refusal, to have the railway constructed under Part Two of the Provincial Act, if Mr. Pugsley is prepared to make such modifications in the standard of construction as will make such a railway practicable. Mr. Flemming suggests a conference between a committee of the Provincial Government and the Minister of Railways and Mr. Pugsley with that end in view.

By this offer the Provincial Government meet every objection raised by Mr. Pugsley against granting the subsidy for the railway. Part 2 of the Provincial Act requires the road to be built to Grand Falls and operation by the L. C. R. This is Mr. Pugsley's own suggestion.

The action of the Provincial Government leaves no doubt of their desire to see a railway built in the St. John Valley without further delay. It only remains for Mr. Pugsley to name a date for the conference.






