STANDING RULES

FOR THE
THE SOCIETY FOR PROMOTING CHRISTIAN KNOWLEDGE
THE BISHOP OF THE
CONSTITUTION AND GOVERNMENT

DIOCESAN CHURCH SOCIETY OF NOVA SCOTIA

- I. His Excellency the **LIEUTENANT GOVERNOR OF NOVA SCOTIA**, for the time being, and the **SOCIETIES FOR THE PROPAGATION OF THE GOSPEL**, and for **PROMOTING CHRISTIAN KNOWLEDGE** shall be respectfully requested to be the **PATRONS** of this Society.
- II. The **BISHOP** of the Diocese shall be the **PRESIDENT** of the Society, with a control over all their proceedings. His approval shall be necessary for the completion of all important acts of the Society, and especially for the revocation or alteration of any of the standing rules, and for making any addition to them.
- III. There shall be two or more **VICE PRESIDENTS**, of whom the **Archdeacon** of Nova Scotia shall be the first; a **SECRETARY**, an **ASSISTANT SECRETARY**, when necessary, and a **TREASURER**.
- IV. There shall be a **Standing Committee**, consisting of the **Officers**, all the **Clergy**, and as many **Laymen** as it shall be thought convenient to choose at the **Annual Meeting** of the Society. The **Lay Members** shall continue in the Committee for a year, or until other **Lay Members** be chosen in their place; and any or all of them may be re-elected. Seven of the Committee shall be a **quorum**, provided four of them be **Laymen**.
- V. The Society shall be open to all **Members of the Church**; all of whom shall be invited to unite with it. **Ten pounds**, paid at any one time, shall qualify a person to be a **Member** during his life; and the payment, in advance, of any sum, *however small*, shall qualify a person to be a member for a year.

VI. The Members of the Church, in every part of the Province, shall be invited to co-operate with the Diocesan Society, by joining Committees of it, which shall be formed, under the direction of their respective Clergymen, either in each Mission or Parish, or in more than one Mission or Parish united, as shall be deemed most convenient, and in strict accordance with the design and rules of the Diocesan Society; and it is recommended to the Committees to forward their funds, as they may be collected, to the General Committee, who will faithfully apply them to the general objects of the Society; but when the Local Committees desire it, they shall receive books, at cost and charges, to the amount of one-fourth of their remittances.

VII. There shall be one General Meeting of the whole Society, including any Members of the Local Committees who can conveniently attend, on such day and at such place as the President may name, of which due notice will be given, with an invitation to every Committee to send at least one Clergyman and two Laymen to represent such Committee, and with a recommendation that each Committee shall meet at some convenient time, immediately before the General Meeting of the Society, that any necessary suggestions may be offered to the representatives of the Committees for their guidance at the General Meeting. And a Special General Meeting may be called at any time and in any place, when the President, or, in his absence, two or more Vice Presidents, shall consider it desirable to appoint such Special General Meeting.

VII. The objects to which the attention of the Society shall be directed, shall be, generally, those which have engaged the two great Church Societies, in England, for the Propagation of the Gospel, and for Promoting Christian Knowledge, and none other.

IX. The following objects shall more particularly engage the attention of the Society, as soon as their means may enable them to afford such attention:

- 1.—Supplies of Books and Tracts from the stores of the Society for Promoting Christian Knowledge, and none other, except in cases where other Books or Tracts, in strict conformity with the principles of the Established Church, and particularly adapted to local circumstances, shall first be carefully examined and approved by a Committee of Revision, to be appointed by the General Committee; the approval of which General Committee shall be necessary in the next place; after which the books must likewise receive the written approbation of the Bishop.
- 2.—Missionary visits to neglected and destitute places, under the direction of the Bishop.
- 3.—Upholding, by all possible and proper means, the Collegiate Establishments at Windsor.

- 4.—Assistance to deserving young men, desirous of being qualified for the Ministry of the Church, but requiring aid in pursuing their studies, at the Collegiate Establishment at Windsor.
- 5.—Aid to Sunday and other Schools, in which due attention is paid to instruction in the principles of the Established Church.
- 6.—Encouragement to the instruction and training of respectable Teachers for Sunday and Daily Schools.
- 7.—Assistance to the erection or enlargement of Churches and Chapels belonging to the Established Religion, in peculiar or extreme cases.
- 8.—Assistance to the erection of Parsonage Houses.
- 9.—Provision for Assistant Missionaries.
- 10.—Assistance to the Endowment of Parishes.

To these objects, generally, the general contributions will be applied; while contributors, who desire it, may have their individual contributions scrupulously confined to any one or more of these objects. And as some Members of the Church, who are not unmindful of the great spiritual wants in their own neighbourhood, still feel constrained, in pious gratitude for the blessings they enjoy, to allot something, however small, from the means with which a gracious Providence has blessed them, towards the spread of the glorious Gospel among the nations which still sit in darkness—

X. This Society will gladly receive and forward to the Society for the Propagation of the Gospel, whatever sums may be given for the conversion and instruction of the Heathen; to which object such sums will be strictly confined by the East India Committee of that Society.

XI. Books and Tracts will generally be on sale, at cost and charges; and whenever, in particular cases, a deviation from this rule is desired, it must be considered by the Standing Committee, and only permitted when recommended by them and approved by the President, or, in his absence, by two or more of the Vice Presidents.

XII. All Meetings of the Society and of the Committee shall be opened and closed with the prayers used by the two Societies in England, adapted to our situation, under the direction of the Bishop.

PRAYERS

To be used at "all meetings of the Society, and of the Committees," before they commence business.

PREVENT us, O Lord, in all our doings, with Thy most gracious favour; and further us with Thy continual help; that in all our

works, begun, continued, and ended in Thee, we may glorify Thy holy name, and finally by Thy mercy obtain everlasting life, through Jesus Christ our Lord. AMEN.

O God, from whom all holy desires, all good counsels, and all works of piety and charity do proceed, we beseech Thee to visit with Thy favour our Sovereign Lady, Queen VICTORIA; and so rule her heart that she may in all things seek Thy honour and glory. Prosper with Thy blessing the designs of this Society. Comfort with Thy grace those benefactors who contribute to its support. Bless the ministry of Thy servants, the Clergy; the endeavours of all who are engaged in promoting the knowledge of true religion in the parent Kingdom, and the labours of those Missionaries who are spreading the same in the Colonies of the Empire. And may Thy Holy Spirit direct all our consultations to the advancement of Thy Glory and the good of Thy Church, through Jesus Christ our Lord. AMEN.

O MERCIFUL GOD, who has made all men, and hatest nothing that Thou hast made, nor wouldest the death of a sinner, but that he should be converted and live: Have mercy upon all Jews, Turks, Infidels, and Heretics, and take from them all ignorance, hardness of heart, and contempt of Thy Word; and so fetch them home, blessed Lord, to Thy flock, that they may be saved among the remnant of the true Israelites, and be made one fold under one Shepherd, Jesus Christ our Lord, who breath and moveth with Thee and the Holy Spirit, one God, world without end. AMEN.

ALMIGHTY GOD, Father of all mercies, we, Thine unworthy servants, do give Thee most humble and hearty thanks for all Thy goodness and loving-kindness to us and to all men: more particularly, for the providential support by which this Society hath been hitherto sustained. But above all, for Thine inestimable love in the redemption of the world, by Thy blessed Son, for the means of grace, and for the hope of glory, which Thou hast given us in the same our Lord and Saviour Jesus Christ; to Whom, with Thee and the Holy Ghost, be all honour and glory, world without end. AMEN.

OUR FATHER, which art in Heaven, hallowed be Thy name. Thy kingdom come. Thy will be done in earth as it is in Heaven. Give us this day our daily bread. And forgive us our trespasses as we forgive them that trespass against us. And lead us not into temptation; but deliver us from evil: for thine is the kingdom, and the power, and the glory, for ever and ever. AMEN.

WHEN THE BUSINESS IS ENDED.

THE grace of our Lord Jesus Christ, and the love of God, and the fellowship of the Holy Ghost, be with us all, evermore. AMEN.

APPENDIX

The Standing Committee meets in Halifax on the third Friday in each month, from November to May inclusive; and all applications for aid should be forwarded to the Secretary, at least a week before either of those dates.

Every application for aid should contain the following information, in defect of which, the application must be postponed for fuller particulars:

For aid in the erection of a Church —

- 1.—The precise situation, especially with reference to the nearest Church, and to the amount of population within five miles of the Church.
- 2.—The Title of the Ground, on which the building is to be erected.
- 3.—The size of the building; the numbers it can accommodate; and probable amount of the congregation that will usually attend it.
- 4.—The supposed cost of the building; the progress it has made toward completion; and the amount of contributions on the spot in money or labour.

The following Resolution was passed at the General Meeting held on the 8th of March, 1848:

Resolved, That the District Associations shall have the privilege of choosing Members of the General Committee resident in Halifax, as their Representatives in the General Committee.

At a Meeting of the General Committee on the 2nd of February, 1849, it was

Resolved, That this Society employ at least six Clergymen to minister as Assistants in larger Missions, where from the extent of the mission it is impossible for the resident Pastor to render adequate service. That the Society will allow £50 to each of these Clergymen, so soon as a similar sum shall have been adequately secured by the People of the Mission.

With reference to the above Resolution, it was Resolved on the 17th August, 1849 —

That no part of the funds of this Society shall be paid under that resolution until the first and each subsequent quarterly payment of the £50 to be provided by the People in such cases, is actually paid in advance to the Treasurer of the Local Committee.

The following Resolution was passed at a meeting of the Standing Committee, September 4th, 1850:

Whereas, the six Assistant Missionaries authorised by the vote of February 2d, 1849, have already been appointed; and the Committee are informed that three additional Missionaries are required.

Resolved, That the sum of £150 be appropriated for the payment of three such Missionaries in destitute places, subject to the same regulations made relative to the said Missionaries already appointed.

It was also

Resolved, That application be made to the Society for the Propagation of the Gospel to engage and send out a Travelling Missionary, to be employed in the destitute parts of this Province, and that aid be solicited from the Society to the same extent as in the case of the six Missionaries lately supplied.

Extract from a letter received by the Venerable The Archdeacon from the Rev. the Secretary of the Society for the Propagation of the Gospel:

"I have only just time to announce that the Society willingly consents to the proposal contained in your letter, and will allow stipends of £50 sterling a-year to each of three additional Assistant Missionaries, on the conditions named.

"The Society will also allow a stipend of £50, on the same terms, for a Travelling Missionary."

September 14th, 1850, the Venerable The Archdeacon communicated to the Committee the mournful intelligence of the death of the Bishop of Nova Scotia. Whereupon, a Sub-Committee was formed, by whose suggestion the following Resolutions were adopted as the sentiments of the Society:

Resolved,

I. That while humbly submitting to the will of Almighty God, and acknowledging his wisdom in every dispensation, this Society desires to record its sense of the loss which, in common with the Church in this Diocese, it has sustained by the death of the Right Rev. John, Lord Bishop of Nova Scotia, its first founder, its only President, and its constant friend.

II. That this Society wishes to acknowledge the important benefits which have arisen from the fostering care and judicious counsels of our beloved Bishop, in advancing the objects which it desires to accomplish.

III. That this Society would express its sympathy with the sorrow of those whose nearer ties of kindred render their bereavement more distressing; while, at the same time, it is thankful for the consolation given in the everlasting Gospel of Christ, "Blessed are the dead which die in the Lord from henceforth, yea, saith the Spirit, that they may rest from their labors; and their works do follow them." Rev. 14: 13.

FORM OF BOND FOR PAYMENT OF ASSISTANT MISSIONARIES.

Know all men by these presents, that we _____, and Province both of _____, in the county of _____, and Province of Nova Scotia, are held and firmly bound to Lawrence Hartshorne, of Halifax aforesaid, Esquire, Treasurer of the Diocesan Church Society of Nova Scotia, in the penal sum of £300, of lawful money of the Province aforesaid, to be paid to the said L. H., or to his successor, or successors in office, for which payment well and truly to be made, we bind ourselves and each of us, our, and each of our heirs, executors and administrators, firmly by these presents. Sealed with our seals, and dated the _____ day of _____ in the year of our Lord _____

Whereas, the said A and B are parishioners of the Parish _____ of _____, and have agreed to execute the above bond or obligation to the said L. H., as Treasurer of the said Diocesan Church Society of Nova Scotia, and to his successor or successors in office, for the purpose of securing to the Assistant Missionary of said Parish to be appointed by the Rector thereof, and approved by the Bishop of the Diocese, the punctual payment of that portion of the salary payable to him by the said Parish. Now the condition of this obligation is such that if the above bounden _____, their heirs, executors, administrators, or either of them do and shall well and truly pay or cause to be paid to the said L. H., as Treasurer, as aforesaid, or his successor or successors in office, the just and full sum of £50 of lawful money of Nova Scotia, in each and every year, for three years from the above date by four even and equal quarterly payments, the first payment thereof to be made on the day of the date of the above bond or obligation, and so in advance every quarter, without fraud or further delay, then this obligation to be void otherwise, to remain in full force and virtue.

The Venerable the Archdeacon took the chair at 7 o'clock.

The proceedings commenced with singing the 100th Psalm.

The Secretary read the Report.

The Honourable the Chief Justice, V. P., then moved the first Resolution:

I. *Resolved*, That the Report now read be received, printed and circulated, under the direction of the Standing Committee:

Which was seconded by the Rev. J. Robertson.

The Rev. J. C. Cochran moved the second Resolution :

II. Resolved, That the General Meeting of this Society adopt the Resolutions passed by the Standing Committee relative to the eminent character and services of our late Bishop, and the loss which this Diocese and his own family have sustained by his removal; and we at the same time acknowledge the urgent necessity for the immediate appointment of a Bishop of this Diocese, as recommended in the late letter from His Grace the Archbishop of Canterbury to the Archdeacon and Clergy.

Which was seconded by the Hon. Mr. Justice Bliss.

The Rev. H. L. Owen moved the third Resolution :

III. Resolved, That we desire again to record our gratitude to Almighty God for that measure of success which has attended our own efforts; and for the still greater success which has been accorded to the kindred Societies in the neighboring Provinces.

Which was seconded by the Rev. W. M. Godfrey.

The Rev. C. Elliott moved the fourth Resolution :

IV. Resolved, That this Society would express its growing conviction of the advantages arising from a direction of its funds and exertions toward the support of Missionaries in this Diocese.

Which was seconded by J. J. Marshall, Esq. M.P.P.

The Hon. M. B. Almon moved the fifth Resolution :

V. Resolved, That the Hon. Mr. Justice Bliss be a Vice President of this Society; and the following members of this Society be elected members of the Standing Committee for the ensuing year: [See List of Officers on 3rd page.]

Which was seconded by the Rev. T. H. White.

The Meeting was then dismissed with the benediction from the Venerable the Archdeacon.

REPORT.

We cannot assemble to commemorate another anniversary of this Society without being painfully reminded that one of its constituent parts is wanting; that part which is composed of the Bishop of the Diocese as our President. We assume the melancholy satisfaction of expressing our unfeigned sorrow for the loss of him who so lately occupied that important position. We have many reasons for a grateful regard for his memory, and we desire now to record this sincere though humble tribute of affection.

The want of a Bishop, as overseer and guide to the Church among us is also to be indeed deeply deplored by all who love the beauty and order of our Zion. We offer our earnest prayers to the Ruler over all that he will not suffer us to remain long without a Chief Pastor and Spiritual Ruler.

This Society cannot but regard with the greatest interest the efforts which are now about to be made to provide an income for our future Bishops. Although that provision does not come within the range of the Society's objects, yet we urge its claims as an imperative duty upon the attention and liberality of every member of the Church in this Diocese.

We are thankful for this opportunity of expressing gratitude to our Heavenly Father for that measure of success with which he has been pleased to crown our efforts during the past year. We trust, that through the Divine blessing we have been the favoured means of setting forward the honour of God and the salvation of men. We have much gratification in declaring our conviction of the undiminished interest which is still felt throughout the Province in the operations of the Society. This is manifested by the expression of such sentiments on the part of many of the Local Committees, and by the efforts now making to advance the great work we have in hand. The benefit of its exertions is unanimously acknowledged both in providing for the visible materials of our Church, and in promoting that inward spirit of unity and Christian charity which constitutes its vitality. We cannot but regret that we have been left so far behind by our sister Societies in the neighbouring Provinces; while we rejoice in their greater prosperity, we indulge the hope that in future years

we may, by greater liberality, keep pace with them in the common labour.

It would, perhaps, be productive of much good if the Society could be made somewhat more the centre of personal attraction to all the Clergy, so that they might regard it as furnishing not only the means for their support, but as instrumental in providing them with mental instruction and recreation.

It appears very evident, both from the experience of the past year and from the sentiments of several Local Committees, that the value of our efforts as a Missionary Society will be fully understood and appreciated; and that it will in this character commend itself to the esteem and affection of every member of our Church. The effort which we are making in this direction, entails upon us even now a heavy responsibility, and will probably, for the present, prevent the Committee from devoting much of the Society's funds to any other object. The Society for the Propagation of the Gospel still continues to encourage our exertions by proportionate support. We may confidently hope that that venerable institution will cherish the child of its adoption until its own resources may prove sufficient for its stability.

May it please Almighty God to bless the labours of the Committee for the ensuing year, to guide all their counsels with the spirit of unity, peace and concord, and to give them the spirit of a sound mind and right judgment in all things.

EXPENDITURE.

books.

The Society has expended in books and tracts from its Depository, during the past year, £61 13s. 8d. The greater part of this amount has been returned to the several Local Committees as the fourth part of their contributions, which part is left at their disposal to be either expended in books from the Depository or devoted toward endowment.

There have been but two grants made: one to Rev. A. Milledge, of books and tracts, £5; one to Rev. R. Brine, £2.

The Depository has issued since the last Report, 56 Bibles, 38 Testaments, 751 Prayer Books, 3400 Tracts, 456 bound Books, and other publications.

It is very desirable that some plan should be adopted by which more of the useful books in the Society's Depository might be distributed throughout the Province. They would tend to check that growing evil which takes its rise in the unsound teaching of many publications which are so diligently circulated.

TRAVELLING MISSIONARIES.

There is at present but one Travelling Missionary supported by this Society, who is employed on the Eastern Shore of the Province. One of the two who last year were thus engaged, has lately accepted the more settled position of Assistant Missionary in one of the larger parishes. The Society has expended for this object £281 5s.

That the attention of the Committee is still turned in this direction, will appear from a Resolution passed September 4th, 1850, requesting the Society for the Propagation of the Gospel to aid them in procuring and maintaining a Missionary to supply the place of the one who has retired. The Society for the Propagation of the Gospel has most kindly acceded to the request, and promised £50 yearly toward his support.

KING'S COLLEGE.

The Society still acknowledges the third of its objects, viz.: "Upholding by all possible and proper means the Collegiate establishments at Windsor." It would gladly thus devote a part of its funds, did not objects of more immediate importance first demand its attention. But it would earnestly commend the claims of the Institution to the attention of all members of the Church.

STUDENTS AT WINDSOR.

During the past year, two students at Windsor have received assistance from this Society. The amount thus expended is £45. A loan of £10 to aid a candidate for orders has been returned.

The Society has turned its attention rather toward provision for those who have been ordained, supposing it better to provide for such as have entered the sacred ministry, than to assist in preparing those who, after such preparation and admission to Holy Orders, would have no means of support.

CHURCH SCHOOLS.

The very small sum of £5 has been paid under this head. The more pressing calls upon the Society from other quarters, have, for the present, averted the attention of the Committee from this most useful and fruitful field of labour.

There is, no doubt, a deserving call for aid under this object. If the funds of the Society would admit of it, assistance would be gladly afforded.

ASSISTANT MISSIONARIES.

It is under this head that the Society has been making the most strenuous exertions during the past year. It appears to assert at once the most just and the most pressing claim upon our attention, and it is the object toward which we most gladly see the funds of the Society devoted, that the word of God may be thus sent forth, accompanied by its lawful and authorised teachers. There are at present seven Assistant Missionaries supported in part by the Society. Their maintenance entails upon us the responsibility of £350 per annum. As a reserve fund for this purpose, there has been this year deposited in the Bank £150, on interest, at 3 per cent. per annum. The Society is prepared to support two more when they may be obtained. The conditions upon which aid is granted appear to have been, thus far, willingly and cheerfully complied with by the people; and their exertions do not seem to lessen our general income. This Society has every reason to be grateful for the blessings which have attended their efforts in this direction, and every cause for encouragement to proceed in the labour. The amount expended for this object is £146 11s. 8d.

The Rev. E. Gilpin, Rector, Annapolis, while thanking the Committee for aid in providing that clerical help of which he stood much in need, writes :

"It gives me great pleasure to add, that help is now abundantly supplied. The Rev. James Bartlett, very carefully selected by the Society for the Propagation of the Gospel with a view to this service, and appointed by our late revered Bishop to this place, has been labouring among us since September last. He appears to me well qualified, in every respect, for the kind of duty he has undertaken, and devotes himself to it with a ready mind. His ministrations, too, are happily acceptable wherever they are

extended; and, we may earnestly hope, are accompanied by the continual flow of the Divine blessing.

"It will, I trust, prove very satisfactory to the Committee to be thus assured of the success of their efforts in this direction, and that nothing shall be wanting on my part to render permanent the benefit we enjoy by their means."

The Rev. Mr. Bartlett thus choicely expresses his sentiments:

"In addressing you with reference to my connection with the Diocesan Church Society, I feel that it would be unnecessary to occupy your attention with many particulars respecting my position at Annapolis. I have much satisfaction in stating that my reception at Annapolis was such as to afford me the highest gratification; and I trust, that in the discharge of my duty I shall always be supported by such encouraging manifestation of good will on the part of those for whom 'I must give account,' and to whom I would say with the Apostle, 'We preach not ourselves, but Christ Jesus the Lord, and ourselves your servants for Jesus' sake.' On my arrival at Annapolis, Mr. Gilpin proposed an arrangement for the division of duty as follows. Mr. Gilpin takes the whole service at Annapolis every Sunday morning. I have full service at Annapolis every Sunday afternoon. I have also full service alternately at Dalhousie and Rosette every Sunday morning; and Mr. Gilpin has full service alternately at Rosette and Perrotte every Sunday afternoon. Till the end of November there was also morning service at Annapolis every Wednesday.

"With a view to make myself known to the people generally, I have visited at 164 houses in Annapolis, Dalhousie, Rosette and Perrotte, beside assisting in the visitation of the sick.

"I beg to take this opportunity to make grateful acknowledgment of my obligation to the Diocesan Church Society for the grant of £50 so liberally contributed to my salary."

ENDOWMENT.

The sum of £74 4s. 3d. has been placed in the hands of the Endowment Sub-Committee, an account of which will be given in their Report. This amount has been derived from special donations and from one-fourths returned.

The Standing Committee also entrusted to the Endowment Sub-Committee interest of a sum of money lodged in the Bank as a reserve fund to provide for the salaries of Missionaries, both travelling and assistant. There has been transferred to King's College, £1 6s., and for benefit of Heathen, &c., £7 8s. 6d.; which sums were contributed for those especial purposes. There has also been expended for the Depository £27 3s. 6d.; for printing the Report £30; for other incidental expenses mentioned in the Treasurer's account, £19 9s. 6d. making a total expenditure for the year 1850, £971 1s., and showing a balance due the Treasurer of £60 9s. 9d.

MEMBERS OF THE SUB-COMMITTEE
REPORT
 OF THE
ENDOWMENT SUB-COMMITTEE.

In accordance with the recommendation of the General Committee, the Endowment Sub-Committee tender their Report of Proceedings during the past year.

The amount placed at their disposal has been small, and their operations have, of course, been proportionate. But there is no reason to be disheartened in "the day of small things." Your Sub-Committee are firmly convinced of the great importance of the effort, and that many advantages will probably arise from a continuation of your exertions in this direction.

The funds which have been entrusted to this Sub-Committee have been derived from special donations both to general and particular endowment, from the reserved one-fourth of contributions from several Local Committees, and from a grant by the Standing Committee to the General Endowment Fund.

The special contributions and reserved fourths can, of course, be drawn only by the Parish or Mission in whose favour the money has been entrusted to the Diocesan Church Society. Out of the General Endowment Fund, your Sub-Committee is authorised to make grants (subject to the confirmation of the Standing Committee,) for the encouragement of, and proportionate to the local exertions in any Parish or Mission.

These particulars have been given, and the accompanying statement is made to remove the misapprehension which seems to exist in the minds of some relative to the operations of this Sub-Committee, and the disposal of the funds committed to their care.

During the past year there has been granted from the general fund, £10 toward the endowment of St. John's, Truro, to meet an exertion on the part of the Parishioners. That Parish has also withdrawn £2, that part of the one-fourth contributions for 1850 which was reserved toward its endowment.

A grant of £15 from the general fund has also been made to meet the very laudable exertions of the Parish of Tonby, Liverpool. The sum of £8 2 6 has been returned to the Rector and Churchwardens, being the one-fourth of contributions from the Local Committee for 1850, reserved toward that object. In both instances, great care has been used to secure the proceeds of the whole investment — both the small grants above-named and the amount raised by the people — for the support of the Rector or Missionary.

ENDOWMENT RULES.

The following Rules for the guidance of the Endowment Sub-Committee were adopted by the Standing Committee, May 17th, 1850:

I. The investment of Endowments may be made in lands, houses, stock in banks, or other companies, money invested in mortgages, or other securities, to be approved of by the Endowment Sub-Committee, and to be conveyed and held for the benefit of the incumbent or resident Missionary, for the time being, of any Parish or Mission for which they are designed, the said incumbent or resident Missionary to receive the yearly proceeds only of the interest or rents arising from such Endowment.

II. The conveyance or trust of such Endowment may be made either to the Society for the Propagation of the Gospel, or to the Church Corporation of the Parish, or to the Diocesan Church Society, if it should hereafter become incorporated.

III. When real property is purchased and conveyed for Endowment, it shall be free from any debt or incumbrance.

IV. The annual proceeds arising from such Endowments shall be withheld from any incumbent or resident Missionary of any Parish or Mission, who may be suspended by the Bishop of the Diocese from performing public services in the Churches in his Parish or Mission, during the continuance of such suspension.

V. The Endowment Sub-Committee shall hold any sums contributed toward the endowment of any Parish or Mission, as well as the reserved one-fourth of any contributions that may be made by any Parish or Mission, in trust for such Parish or Mission, and obtain such rate of interest for the money as may be practicable consistent with safety, until an opportunity shall arise of investing it for the permanent endowment of such Parish or Mission; and if, in the judgement of the Endowment Sub-Committee, such opportunity or proposition for endowment shall come within the true intent and scope of the foregoing regulations, they shall authorize the said one-fourth to be paid to the Parish or Mission so applying for it.

VI. If any difficulty shall arise as to whether any opportunity or proposition for endowment be agreeable to the foregoing Rules, or if any other point relative thereto should be disputed or doubted, the question shall be referred to the Standing Committee of the Diocesan Church Society at their next meeting then ensuing.

VII. All applications from any Parish or Mission to the Endowment Sub-Committee for aid, shall be signed by the Rector and Church Wardens of such Parish, or by the resident Missionary, accompanied by a resolution of the Local Committee of the Diocesan Church Society in its favor, in such Mission; and shall state the nature, situation, value, and annual profits of the investment desired to be made, the names of those in whose behalf it is to be made, the office, where it should be duly registered, the sums that are contributed for its purchase, and all other particulars which may enable the Endowment Sub-Committee to form a correct judgment. All such applications to be made to the Secretary of the Diocesan Church Society, who is ex-officio Secretary of the Endowment Sub-Committee.

At a meeting of the Endowment Sub-Committee, 23d February, 1850, it was Resolved that the following notice should be published:

"The Endowment Sub-Committee, to whom the General Committee of the Diocesan Church Society has intrusted the care of funds contributed for Endowment, and the consideration of applications for Endowment, beg to state to the Parishes that they are ready to receive any sums contributed for Endowments, either by one-fourth of the annual contributions that may be devoted to that purpose, or otherwise, and to take care of the same for the Endowment of Parishes for which they may be contributed: And the Sub-Committee are also ready to receive any applications or statements that may be made by any Parish respecting Endowments; such communications to be addressed to the Secretary of the General Committee."

May 15th, 1850, it was Resolved, That the Endowment Sub-Committee do meet *pro re nata*, as may be deemed necessary, on notice from the Secretary.
