An Act to amend an Act passed in the eighth year of Her Majesty's Reign, intituled, "*An Act to regulate the Culling and Measurement of Timber, Masts, Spars, Deals, Staves, and other Articles of a like nature.*" (See further, page 1249)

**W**HEREAS it is expedient to remove certain doubts which have been entertained, touching the intention of the Legislature, in relation to the Culling and Measuring of Deals ; Be it therefore enacted, &c., Preamble.

5 That so much of the twenty-fourth Section of the Act passed in the eighth year of Her Majesty Reign, and intituled, "*An Act to regulate the Culling and Measurement of Timber, Masts, Spars, Deals, Staves, and other Articles of a like nature,*" as is  
10 conveyed and expressed by the words " or assorted," shall be and is hereby repealed, and that henceforward the said words " or assorted," in the said Section, shall be held and considered to form no part thereof. Section 24 of 8 V., c. 49 amended.
