HON. PATRICK MAGUIRE DEAD. He was a Prominent and Successful Irish-American Journalist.

The Hon. Patrick Maguire, of Boston, Mass., died on Saturday last at his home in that city, fortified by the rites of the Church...

His first employment here was as a newspaper compositor. He worked on several newspapers between 1852 and 1859. After leaving the case, he embarked in the real estate business...

Mr. Maguire took great pride in his paper. As a thorough practical printer, he gave much time to its typographical appearance. He loved to talk of his trials and discouragements in issuing the first number...

Mr. Maguire was best known as a Democratic politician. For a generation he was a member of the Democratic city committee. He held but two public offices...

He was elected a member of the Democratic city committee in 1862. He then lived in Hudson street, which was at that time ward 8. He afterward lived in Canton street for many years...

During the years that have since intervened he has been by common consent the leader of the Democratic organization. His political power has been many times threatened...

His service to the Democratic party was very valuable. He developed unusual capacity for party management, and his advice was always in the direction of the nomination of the best men available for office...

Socially, Mr. Maguire had many calls. He was a member of the Roxbury Club, the Charitable Irish Association, the Press Club, the New England Club and the Catholic Union...

In poultry, sales of turkeys a little off in color were made at 6c to 6 1/2c; but good stock sold slow at 7c to 7 1/2c; chickens, 6c to 6 1/2c; ducks, 7c to 7 1/2c; and geese 5c to 5 1/2c per lb.
