REPORT

OF THE

Primitive Methodist Missionary Society,

CANADA,

For the Year ending 30th April, 1859.

As the "CHRISTIAN JOURNAL" has kept up before the public every incident worth notice, in relation to the Missions, and will continue to report every communication that the Missions may send, a long preface will not be necessary in introducing our Missionary affairs in this Report.

Some months ago, the Missionary Committee directed that each Missionary on a Station should draw up an account of the state and prospects of his Mission, for insertion, as the best course to be adopted. All the Stations except two have responded; but as those communications are far too long for insertion, we proceed to give the substance of them.

KINGSTON.—This Station is steadily improving; and the Superintendent has been specially re-appointed by the last Conference, with a reference to Church building. We trust those measures of providing for the worship of God, and the extension of the Station into new places which is contemplated, will be attended with success the coming year.

PORTLAND.—We have had our trials and successes during the year now closed. We have had 26 removals—13 have departed; but we have filled up the chasm, and report a small increase. During the year £32 13s. 7d. has been raised on behalf of the Parsonage House; £48 7s. 6d. for Mission income; £55 5s. 10d. towards the Missionary's support; £2 10s. 11½d. Children's Fund;

and we regret to report the *small sum* of fourteen shillings and one penny for Conference and Sick Preachers' Fund!! Small, however, as are the sums, when viewed in connection with the Station, we have as Missionaries laboured to the utmost of our ability; and we trust there will be an onward progress on this Station; and that point will ere long be gained, a "self-supporting Branch" of the Connexion in Canada.

NAPANEE.—In the Fall of 1855 this Mission was commenced, by the appointment of a Missionary, who laboured with much success; but the subsequent years were years of trial. Many, whose attachment appeared for a while *strong*, seceded from the work, and failed in the hour of trial. At present we have *nine* preaching appointments, two of which we have taken up lately; but one of our difficulties is an insufficient supply of Local Preachers, to fill up the appointments, and the places are a considerable distance from each other. Financially, we are about as last year; and after filling up a number of vacancies in our ranks through removals, we have a small increase for the year; and feel hopeful that God will prosper us in our labours the coming year.

We believe our efforts for the year would have been more successful had the health of our Missionary been good; but failing strength rendered it impossible for him to *visit* the Members of the Church, consequently there was a shrinking in the work, which we deeply regret. GUELPH.—We thank God for what he has done for us on this Mission the past year. After filling up the ranks occasioned by deaths, fallen, and removals, we are able to report 85 members as the total of the Mission force. In the winter we held a protracted meeting at Brock Road, and a precious revival took place: it was supposed about 50 persons were awakened: 37 joined our Society; the rest went to other Churches. We *immediately* proceeded to provide for our additional charge, in arranging for a new chapel, which will be opened this summer. We believe it will be debtless, as most of the materials will be given, and a large proportion of the labour performed gratuitously. We have peace in our borders, and are expecting greater things.

PEEL AND WELLESLEY.—With respect to this Station, we have an increase of 25 Members; but our Mission finances have *declined*, through the straightened state of finance in the country: but our Missionary monies are in *advance*; and our congregations are improved: our Local Preachers have well sustained the Mission, some of whom have travelled more than 60 miles to Sabbath appointments; but in consequence of nearly one-half of our appointments being in an entirely "new country," little or nothing can be obtained from such places towards a Missionary's support.
