### ROSEBERY STEPS OUT

His Resignation Placed in the Hands of the Queen.

LORD SALISBURY SUMMONED

He will be entrusted with the formation of a Ministry—the Nations and the Commander-in-Chief—Prince Henry of Battenberg as Viceroy of India.

London, June 22.—The Government was defeated yesterday on the motion of Mr. William St. John Broderick, Conservative member for the Guilford division of Surrey, to reduce the salary of the Secretary of War by £100 on account of an alleged deficiency in the army stores and munitions of war, chiefly cordite. The motion was adopted by a vote of 132 to 123. Progress was immediately reported.

The general belief expressed this evening is that the defeat of the Government means a crisis. The leaders of the Opposition will be wound up in short order. The result of the division was an unexpected one, the papers were handed to the Opposition whip, Mr. Akers-Douglas, to read the figures he returned to the Government whip, Mr. Edward T. Ellis, who had asked read it, when he saw it was a defeat, and returned it to Mr. Douglas, who, as the Opposition had won, was entitled to announce the figures. Mr. Douglas read them and prolonged an excited Opposition. The Conservative leader, Mr. Balfour, then asked what course the Government intended to take, and the Chancellor of the Exchequer, Mr. William Vernon Harcourt, announced that the Government would not discuss the matter until the House proceeded to discuss the Naval Works Bill.
