CUSTOMS REQUIREMENTS

UNITED STATES

Every shipment of whatever nature must be accompanied by:—First, an invoice in duplicate, made in ink or indelible pencil, and signed by the shipper. Second, Bill of Lading (Company's receipt) in duplicate. Third, Export Certificates in duplicate for Canadian Customs.

Live stock, hogs, sheep, etc, in addition to above papers, must have a veterinary certificate signed by a recognized veterinary surgeon, and must state whether or not said animals are for breeding purposes, name of breed, color of animal, and name and age; also if they have been registered in the proper book of record in the United States, and to whom the Customs Agent or Broker will look for such certificate of registry.

Invoice for goods of American manufacture, growth or production must bear indication of such facts, and the shipper shall be required to deliver with the invoice a certificate from the Canadian Customs showing said goods to have been imported from the United States; and when the value of such goods **EXCEEDS \$100.00**, such certificate must show when and from which Canadian Frontier Port said goods were received. Shipper must also furnish **CONSULAR CERTIFICATE** for all shipments valued **OVER \$100.00**; (shippers should use every precaution and know that the Consul uses the proper form, and that they are made for the Port where goods are to be entered).

CONSULAR INVOICES should be way-billed on Money Way Bills, to the Agent at the Customs House Port where goods are to be cleared, and such way bills should show what shipments said Consular Invoice covers.

The freight way bill covering the shipment, should show notation "Consular Invoice to Agent..... (Town) (State) on Money Way Bill No. Date..... as expense or free."

All charges on all shipments destined to a foreign country must be prepaid or guaranteed, the guarantee to be executed on Dominion Express form No. 149 for each shipment which is not prepaid, and this guarantee will be kept on file at the shipping point.

Wearing Apparel and personal effects old or new, are admitted to the United States free of duty only when they actually accompany the passenger (owner).

Exception: Wearing apparel or personal effects of American manufacture, or the property of a citizen or resident of the United States which was taken or shipped to any party in Canada and was left behind for some valid reason and are returned without having been advanced in value or improved in condition upon which the consignee (owner) will be required to make declaration **IN THE UNITED STATES** before a Customs Officer or Customs Notary Public, which declaration, if made, and accepted by United States Customs, will enable the owner to make a free entry of such goods.

Wearing apparel or personal effects offered for entry into the United States under any other condition must be **PREPAID**.

For Postal Remittances to Great Britain and Ireland, Germany, Norway and Sweden, add 10c. for POSTAGE for each remittance, and 15c. each for all other countries.

Foreign Limited Cheques

(Limited to \$50 or the equivalent in Foreign Money)

Are issued in the money of the country on which drawn, and are to be sent by the remitter direct to the payee. They are payable without advice and without discount (except for revenue stamp) upon presentation at the agencies on whom drawn.

Foreign Postal Remittances

This is a system by which the actual money of the country will be delivered at the given address, direct to the payee.

A receipt is given to the remitter for the amount required to be transmitted; also instructions printed in ten different languages, to be sent to the payee, telling him to notify our principal agent in the country (full name and address is given) if the money is not received in ten days.

The rates quoted in this book are for ordinary transportation only, and do not include Marine Insurance, Customs Dues or other Governmental Expenses. Shipments valued in excess of \$50 are charged additional for value according to distance carried.

FREIGHT CLASSIFICATION RULES

The Dominion Express Company gives a receipt for every shipment without reference to the size, value or distance to be carried; this receipt should be carefully preserved and attached to the claim in case of loss, damage or delay.

The Dominion Express Company is not liable for more than \$50 on any shipment, unless a greater value is declared and entered on the receipt at time of shipment.

GRADUATED RATES apply to matter weighing less than 100 pounds when the rate is under \$2.00 per 100 pounds, and to matter weighing less than 50 pounds when the rate is \$2.00 or more per 100 pounds. **Example:** Between points where the rate is \$1.75 per 100 pounds, a box weighing 73 pounds is charged for at the graduated rate under \$1.75, which makes the proper charge on over 70 to 75 pounds \$1.50. (See graduated rates scale on last two pages of this book.)

WHEN THE RATE between any two points is not given in the table of graduated charges use the next higher rate for making price, but do not charge more than for 100 pounds at the actual rate. **Example:** The correct charge for 75 pounds at 80c. per 100 lbs. would be 80c., not \$1.00, according to the graduate on 75 pounds at \$1.00.

All shipments are charged for at gross weight at time of shipment, unless otherwise specially provided for. On shipments of perishable matter, estimated weights are used only when ice is used in preservation. When no ice is used, actual gross weights apply.

EXTRA RATE CHARGES—On shipment subject to extra rates, as one and one-half, or double rate, find graduated rate according to tariff, and then add one-half, or double it, as required. **Example:** If a package weighs 25 lbs. rated at double rate, and the rate to destination is \$1.00 per hundred lbs., the charge for 20 to 25 lbs. is 55 cents. double this, \$1.10, is the proper amount.

VALUATION CHARGES WITHIN CANADA AND THE UNITED STATES—When the value of any merchandise shipment (C.O.D., or otherwise) exceeds \$50, an additional charge is made for value, whether insured or not.

C.O.D. SHIPMENTS—The letters "C.O.D." and amount to be collected, must be plainly marked upon each article with which a bill is sent to be collected on delivery. If shipper requires collection of charge for return of money, the C.O.D. envelope and the package must be plainly marked "C.O.D. \$ and return charges."

All orders to deliver C.O.D. goods without collecting C.O.D. must have the approval of the agent of this Company at the shipping point; shippers will therefore save time by addressing the express agent to whom the goods were delivered, to have C.O.D. released.

Shippers desiring currency or coin different from that current where collection is to be made, must write their instructions plainly on the C.O.D. bill of collection.

Paid C.O.D.'s and Paid Collections will be opened and the contents counted by this Company's employee making the delivery, in the presence of the consignee or his duly authorized agent, and any shortage or uncurrent money made good.

Money packages are put up by shippers, and the contents are not counted by the employees of this Company; consignee should therefore open such packages by cutting the string at the ends of the envelope to preserve the seals.

Watches and Jewelry should be packed separately, and not in the same package with shipments of ordinary merchandise.

The rates of this Company will always be as low as competing companies' rates between the same points.

All claims will be promptly investigated and refund made in case of overcharge.

Where two rates are given in this book { 1 50 } graduate on to any one point thus { 75 } each rate, as per Table of Graduated Charges on last two pages of this book.

On business to or from other Countries, these Rates and Rules will apply to transportation within the United States or Canada.

SECTION "A." The following matter may be charged for at the **Merchandise Rate per 100 lbs. for actual weight**, (pound rates) between all offices. Charges to be prepaid or guaranteed, minimum 35 cents for each Company except when otherwise provided.

The rates on Advertising Matter, given herein, will be applied only on matter distributed gratuitously for advertising purposes and must not be applied on any packages containing articles that are sold to the consignee. Any article of merchandise packed with Advertising Matter will subject the shipment to the regular graduate at merchandise rates.

Address Tags, having an advertisement printed thereon, and given away for advertising purposes.

Advertising Matter, consisting of Printed, Engraved or Photographed Advertisements on Paper, Cloth, Cardboard or Printed Blotters.

Advertising Signs on or under Glass, completely boxed, released, at owner's risk.

Advertising Signs or Cards, without glass, boxed or crated, also **Metal Signs**, not boxed or crated.

Almanac and Pamphlets of similar form to Almanacs devoted to advertising medicines, minimum 35 cents. On packages of Almanacs for city delivery, received by freight for distribution, charge not less than 25 cents each unless regular charge from point of origin is less.

Envelopes, having advertisement printed thereon and given away for advertising purposes.

Fish or Oyster Posters or Signs.

Packages from Commission Merchants, containing Rubber Stamps, Pads, Stencils, Shipping Cards and Advertising Matter.

Stereotype or Electrotype Advertising and Illustrating Plates, including **Illustrating Plates** made by the half-tone process, minimum 25 cents, unless rates under Section "E" are less.

SECTION "B." The following matter may be charged for at the **Merchandise Rate per 100 lbs. for actual weight** (pound rates) between all offices, charges to be prepaid or guaranteed.

Auxiliary Newspapers, Patent Inserts, including **Reading Matter Plates**, Printed or Illustrated **Supplements for Newspapers**, minimum 25 cents.

Dye Houses, Shipments to or from, pound rates, minimum 30 cents.

Laundry, Packages of, minimum 35 cents.

Manufactured Cereal Foods, minimum 35 cents. When carried by two more Companies, minimum 30 cents for each Company.

Matrix (paper moulds for casting stereotype plates), minimum 35 cents.

Samples of Cotton Seed Meal, Oil Cake or Hulls, minimum 35 cents.

Samples of Soap and Soap Powder, from manufacturers, when given away for advertising purposes, minimum 35 cents.

Toilet Paper, minimum 35 cents; when carried by two or more Companies, minimum 25 cents for each Company carrying.

Wall Paper, including Burlap used as a wall covering, minimum 35 cents

SECTION "C." PACKAGES, EACH 7 LBS. OR LESS.

Not applicable to shipments of Silver Coin, Live Animals, Live Birds, or to any matter subject to higher than Merchandise Rates.

One graduate under the through or aggregate rate per 100 lbs. to destination; the through charge not to be less than the graduate charge under the rate of \$2.00 per 100 lbs., except that the sum of the local graduate charges may be assessed when less; when carried by more than two Companies, not less than 10 cents to each Company. If the value exceeds \$50, charge on value in addition to the package rate.

SECTION "D."—CHARGES AT THESE RATES MUST BE PREPAID.

These Rates apply solely to articles named when shipped by manufacturers or publishers of and all regular shippers and dealers in the articles listed.

Each package must be limited to Ten Dollars in value, be PREPAID, have the name of the contents written, stamped or printed thereon, and be so packed that the description may be readily verified by examination.

These rates will not apply to any printed matter named in paragraph (B.) if printed, framed or mounted on anything but paper or cardboard, except Maps, as provided below.

Under the conditions named, charge one cent for each two ounces or fraction thereof, minimum 10 cents; except that packages weighing 50 ounces or more each will be charged two cents per package less than the charge at the rate of one cent for each two ounces or fraction thereof, but the charge on packages weighing less than 50 ounces shall not be more than the charge for 50 ounces; when carried by more than one Company, the minimum charge for each Company is 10 cents.

SECTION "E."—SPECIAL RATES TO MANUFACTURERS AND DEALERS FOR LARGE OR CONTINUOUS SHIPMENTS.

Packages of Merchandise or Samples thereof (not including Jewelry or Imitations of Jewelry, Watch Cases, Watch Movements, Silverware, Sealed Packages from Jewelry Houses, Silversmiths or other dealers in precious metals, Cut Flowers, Live Animals or Live Birds,) value not exceeding \$10, may be forwarded at a rate of one cent per ounce, no charge less than 15 cents per package, charges prepaid. When such packages pass over the lines of more than one Company, not less than 10 cents to each Company carrying. Shipments must be declined at these rates unless the shipper writes or stamps the value on the receipt.

Shipments which have been sent out under this Section may be returned to original shippers, way-billed to collect, at the rates charged on the business when sent out. This rule applies to shipments which may have been delivered as well as to those remaining "on hand" undelivered.
