Sherwood's Backed Name

Anthony Decker, Expert Engraver, His Wife and Her Son Paul in the Law's Clutches at Last.

Detectives Have Chased Them for a Long Time—Man Named Kuntz Also Taken in—The Charge Against Them is Counterfeiting—Arrested in Different Places.

Ottawa, Feb. 2.—The great counterfeit mystery that has been occupying the attention of the Dominion police for months past has at last been solved, and the four principals are safely lodged in the four prison bars. The names of these implicated and where they were arrested are as follows: Anthony Decker, Baltimore; Paul Decker, Woodstock; Mrs. Paul Decker, Hamilton; Hall Kuntz, London.

Counterfeits Were Good. The counterfeiters were excellent reproductions of the originals, and the police were much agitated about them. The case was immediately taken up by Commissioner Sherwood, and in a short time the responsibility for their appearance was traced to a man named Decker, in the employ of the Bank Note Company, Montreal.

It consisted of a combination of letters, which writings Decker, the key for the code was also found, and a counterfeiter back Paul Decker, alias Paul Rose, alias Harry Rose, was arrested in Woodstock yesterday by Constable Parkinson of the Dominion force.
