The number of Students who, during the year, availed themselves of the advantages presented by the Hospital for the practical study of this important branch of their profession was 31.

No death occurred in the Hospital this year.

Since the last annual meeting the name of the Institution has been changed by a Statute of the Legislature of the Province of Quebec, from "The University Lying-in Hospital" to "The University Maternity Hospital." This was done in accordance with a resolution adopted to that effect. The Committee have to thank the Government for a refund of the customary expenses connected with the passage of the bill.

Your Committee hoped that during this year they would have been able to commence the erection of a suitable building in connection with this charity, but regret that they have been unable to do so.

To the Reverend Gentlemen of the Seminary and to the Directors of the City and District Savings Bank, the grateful thanks of the Committee are due for their generous donations.

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The Committee feel that a vote of thanks is due to the Lady collectors who have been so energetic and successful in collecting during this year, and also to those kind friends who have subscribed so liberally.

The Government grant of four hundred and thirty-two dollars has been received.

The Committee beg to return their grateful thanks to Drs. McCALLUM and Browne for their attention during the year.

In recognition of her faithful services during the past year a gratuity of thirty dollars has been unanimously voted to the matron, Mass. SMILLIE.
