The Ontario millers have promised to send a representative exhibit of flour to Jamaica, and Prof. Robertson will prepare an exhibit of Canadian cheeses.

The postmaster general declines to obey the order of Judge Chartrand of Quebec to deliver the letters of an absconding bankrupt to his creditors, and proceedings will be taken in the supreme court to set aside the order.

From July 14 to 31st, 17,082 immigrants arrived at Montreal from the old country; of this number 12,193 settled in Canada and 4,889 in the Western States. Those remaining in Canada brought \$750,000 in the country.

PRINCE GEORGE OF WALES is next to return to England in May next when he will give up the command of the Thrusch on his promotion to the rank of commander, and shortly afterwards it is probable he will be appointed to one of the royal yachts.

The Minister of Marine and Fisheries received a telegram from British Columbia the other day, which states that the salmon run in an extraordinary character and fully equal to last year's. Three canneries took twenty thousand fish in one day. The operations of the government fish hatchery are beginning to tell.

The minister of marine has instructed all Canadian surveyors of shipping to register new vessels according to the provisions of the Merchant's Shipping act, passed by the imperial parliament last year.

A WINNIPEG despatch of the 7th inst. says: Premier Greenway has just made enquiries from various districts of the province and finds that between three and four thousand additional men are wanted for harvesting and threshing. From \$35 to \$45 per month are offered with board. Harvesting operations have commenced, and will be in full blast next week.

The steamer Coban arrived at Montreal on the 7th, with the cargo of the Dominion line steamer Idaho, and on Anticosti Island. Much of it is damaged. It is stated as being probable that another effort will be made to get the Idaho off. Steamship Siberian and Toronto which arrived at Montreal report large quantities of ice both outside the Straits of Belle Isle. Both report the long blocked channel in the straits closed, but there will remain a few bergs to the north of the island.

ACTION is to be taken with reference to the Labrador railway scheme sooner than was expected. A party of English engineers and capitalists is expected to arrive in New York next week on route to Canada, and the Government has been asked to loan the Arctic steamer Alert enable the party to visit Labrador and the Straits of Belle Isle with a view to prospecting. Should they report favorably the scheme will at once be floated on the English market.

SIR CHARLES TUPPER has advised the department of agriculture that the S. S. Iowa from Boston, has landed 356 ewes at Liverpool, England, among which were seven affected with swine fever. Slaughter was accordingly ordered. The Kansas, from Boston, also landed at Liverpool 387 ewes, of which 23 were affected with the fever and were also slaughtered. The live stock shipments from Montreal for July amounted to 17,339 cattle and 18,243 sheep—the largest number yet shipped in one month.

A Rome despatch of the 8th inst. says: In order to officially counteract the rumors of his ill-health the pope celebrated high mass to-day in the Pauline chapel. It was made the occasion of a great state ceremony. His holiness has expressed himself as extremely grieved at the anti-Christian policy of the Italian Government, which is suppressing all religious guilds and seizing their property. This will necessitate the closing in Rome alone of no fewer than 25 churches, several of which will speedily be turned into cafes and theatres, while others will be razed to the ground. The church of St. Peter, which for many centuries has belonged to one of the leading guilds, has been sold to a German brewing company, and will forthwith be turned into a large beer saloon. Another large church, associated with the memory of Michelangelo, will be converted into a theatre and dancing hall.

SIR JOHN A. MACDONALD, Premier of Canada, and Lady Macdonald, accompanied by Sir John's Private Secretary, Mr. Joseph Pope, arrived in this city, via Prince of Wales, on Thursday evening last.
