Minister of Whar. He had
previously held the import
ant position of commander
of the entrenched camp and
mitary governor of Paris.
His predecessor as war min-
ister was Alexandre Miller- GENERAL GALLIENI. and. Gen. Gallieni enforced many reforms i nthe adminis
tration of the war office, and laid down the rule that the various officials must be dependent upon their own judgment. Of late there has been considerable discussion of the war department in the French parliament, some of the depu-
ties and senators aiming to limit the control of the war min-
tir and Gendral offre-over-military affairs. Gen. Gallieni failed to attend the meeting of the army
minnittee of the Chamber of Deputies on March 9 , and the meeting of the council of national defense on March 10 ,
and an official note explained that the war minister had been "prevented" from receiving members of parliament on Fri-

NoMore Books After March 25

A homeless man wrote "Home, Sweet Home!" perhaps no other could have expressed the intense longing-the yearning-the keen pangs of a heart starving for home-for hearthstone and loved ones. John Howard Payne, the author of the words, died in Tunis, a lonely exile, in 1852.

Certainly no words and no music could convey with more feeling that greatest of passions of the human hearl-the desire for a home of its own. But one other desire on earth surpasses it-and that comes-mercifully -only to old age-when it longs for its home " not built with hands, elernal in the heavens."

This world-wide song, with its touching melody and words, occurs in Bishop's opera of "Clari, the Maid of Milan," brought out at Covent Garden in 1823.
