A Good Reform.

The Canadian Pacific Railway Company has announced a reduction in wages, against which there is much murmuring and some talk of a general strike. Machinery are reduced forty cents per day, laborers, twenty cents; carpenters, thirty-five; boiler-makers fifty-five; engineers and firemen's wages fifty per cent per month. In the store department laborers are reduced to \$1.00 per day. Office hands heretofore getting \$35 per month are reduced to \$30. In the running shops a reduction of five per cent is made.
