The Value of the Church.

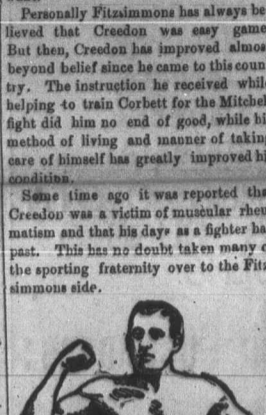
