AT SIR CHARLES'S REQUEST

HON. MR. THOMPSON TO BE LEGAL ADVISER OF THE COMMISSION.

A proposition from an English firm to build the Prince Edward Island Ferry, Mr. Mercer's latest initiative is not expected to be successful.

Oct. 15.—It is understood that Hon. Mr. Thompson, Minister of Justice, has at the request of Sir Charles Tupper, consented to accompany him to Washington as the legal adviser in connection with the Fisheries Commission, as is expected that many points requiring special legal knowledge will come before the commission. The appointment of Mr. Thompson will give general satisfaction and will tend to greatly strengthen the fact of Sir Charles Tupper in his important position on the commission. Mr. Thompson, in his administration of the affairs of the Department of Justice, has proved himself to be one of the soundest and most thoroughly grounded jurists in Canada. In international law he has few equals, and his calm, clear judicial mind, equanimity to every subject and thoroughness in dealing with it, are of inestimable advantage to the Canadian case before the commission.

A proposition is said to have been made to the Government by Mr. G. H. G. of London, who is present building the London and Southern Railway under the Thames, to form a company to build a subway to connect the London and Southern Railway with the London and North Western Railway, in consideration of an annual subsidy of \$2,000,000 for fifty years.
