SEASIDE EAST LUMBER

Secretary Windsor Suspects That It Is Being Smuggled into the U.S. from Canada.

New York, Aug. 12.—Secretary of the Treasury Windsor has ordered that the bonded lumber yard of Burroughs & Co., at Hunter's Point, be closed pending an investigation to be conducted concerning the whereabouts of 2,000,000 feet of Canadian lumber.

This order went into effect Saturday, Deputy Collector Guthrie being placed in charge. It was based upon the report of special Treasury agents who have been quietly looking into the manner in which Canadian lumber has been brought here, and what has become of it.

The result of their investigation was reported privately to Secretary Windsor. It was learned yesterday that the special agents had been unable to find any trace of 2,000,000 feet of the Canadian lumber consigned to Burroughs' bonded lumber yard.

They could not, so it is alleged, find it in store, and consequently the Secretary of the Treasury desired it best to close up this yard until the lumber could be traced.

The duty on lumber of the quality involved is \$2 per thousand feet, so that in this thirty months it has amounted to \$4000.

A little over a year ago a case was discovered in which the bonded lumber yard in Canada ordered to the bonded lumber yard never went into bond at all.

The bonded lumber yard was not unloaded, and the boat was secretly towed down to the basin at South Brooklyn, where the lumber was being put on board a vessel bound for an outside port.

Since then the methods of this imported lumber business have been conducted closely. The investigation in the present case will be conducted in secret.
