LOSS OF THE STEAMER DANIEL STERNMANN, OFF CAPE BARBOUR. (Continued from Halifax Chronicle.)

On Friday, about noon, one of those mysterious rumors which start no one knows how, began to circulate about the city that a terrible wreck had occurred at Sambro. About 1:30 p.m. the rumor was verified by the telegram...
