An Act to incorporate the Town of Oakville.

HEREAS from the rapidly increasing population of the Village of Preamble. Oakville, in the County of Halton, and from its being one of the principal Shipping Ports on Lake Ontario, it is necessary to confer upon the said Village the power of Municipal Government; Therefore Her Ma-5 jesty, &c., enacts as follows:

I. From and after the passing of this Act the inhabitants of the Town of Oakville to be Oakville shall be a body corporate apart from the Township of Trafalgar in an incorporate de Town. which the said Town is situate, and as such shall have perpetual succession and a Common Seal, with such powers as are now by law conferred upon 10 Incorporated Towns in Upper Canada; and the powers of such Corporation shall be exercised by, through and in the name of the Municipality of the Town of Oakville.

II. The said Town of Oakville shall comprise and consist of the following Boundaries of lots and parcels of land, that is to say : Lots Numbers twelve, thirteen, four- the Town. 15 teen, fifteen and sixteen, and the gore adjoining lot sixteen in the third conccssion of Trafalgar, and lots eleven, twelve, thirteen, fourteen, fifteen, sixteen, and the gore, and lot seventeen in the broken front or fourth concession of the said Township of Trafalgar.

III. The said Town of Oakville shall be divided into three Wards in the Division into 20 manner following, that is to say:

IV. Immediately after the passing of this Act it shall be lawful for the Gov-Appointment vernor of this Province to appoint a Returning Officer for the said Town of ing officere at Oakville, which Returning Officer shall appoint the time and place for hold-first election. ing the first election in each Ward of the said Town, of which appointment 25 and of the names of the Deputy Returning Officer for the several Wards he shall give notice by posting the same at least ten days before the election in three or more public places in each of the Wards of the said Town.

V. The duties of the Returning Officer and Deputy Returning Officers, Qualification and the qualifications of the voters and the persons elected as Councillors of electors, &c. 30 at such first election, shall be as prescribed by law with respect to Townships in Upper Canada.

VI. The Collector or Township Clerk of the Township of Trafalgar, or Copy of the other person having the legal custody of the Collector's Roll for the year of the Collecone thousand eight hundred and fifty-six, shall furnish to each Deputy Re- tor's Roll to be 35 turning Officer a true copy of the said Roll so far as the same relates to furnished to Voters resident within the limits of needs of such Words, and so far as such Deputy voters resident within the limits of each of such Wards, and so far as such Returning Roll contains the names of the male freeholders and householders rated officers. upon such Roll in respect of real property lying within such limits, with

the amount of the assessed value of such real property for which they shall be respectively rated on such Roll, which copy shall be verified upon oath or in such manner as is now required by law.

Oath of office of Returning officers, &c.

VII. The said Returning Officer and Deputy Returning Officers before holding the said elections, shall take the same oath or affirmation as is now 5 required by law for Returning Officers and Deputy Returning Officers in Towns in Upper Canada.

VIII. Elections for Councillors of the said Town of Oakville after the quent elections year 1857 shall be held in conformity with the Statutory provisions in respect of the several Incorporated Towns of Upper Canada. 10

Oath required of persons elected, &c.

IX. The several persons who shall be elected or appointed under this Act shall take the same oaths of office and of qualification as are now required by law.

Powers and organization of Council.

X. The said Councillors to be elected under this Act for the said Town, shall be organized in the same manner and in the same way as in any other 15 Incorporated Town in Upper Canada, and have, use and exercise the same powers and privileges as any other Incorporated Town in Upper Canada.

Town separated from Township of Trafalgar.

Provision as to debts.

XI. From and after the passing of this Act the said Town shall cease to form part of the said Township of Trafalgar, and shall, to all intents and purposes, form a separate and independent Municipality, with all the privi- 20 leges and rights of an Incorporated Town in Upper Canada, but nothing herein contained shall affect or be construed to affect any taxes imposed for the payment of any debt contracted by the Township of Trafalgar, but the said Town shall pay to the Treasurer of the said Township of Trafalgar in each and every year until such existing debt be fully paid and dis- 25 charged, the same amount which was collected within the present described limits of the said Town, towards the payment of such debt for the year 1856, and the same shall be a debt against the said Town.

XII. All Acts and parts of Acts and provisions of law or of Parliament, and all Acts, By-laws, Rules and Regulations of any Township Meeting, County Council, or Township Council in Upper Canada, in force in Upper Canada immediately before the time when this Act shall come into force, in so far as the same may be inconsistent with or contradictory to the provisions of this Act, shall be and are hereby repealed, and shall cease to be in force from and after the day when this Act shall come into force.

Public Act. XIII. This Act shall be deemed a public Act.
