BILL.

An Act for taking and recording the votes of members of the Legislature on the final passage of Bills.

WHEREAS twenty members are a quorum of the Preamble. Legislative Assembly; and whereas it is desirable that the votes of the members of the Legislature upon the final passage of Bills should be taken and recorded: Be
5 it therefore enacted, &c.

That in the Legislative Council and in the Legislative Votes to be recorded on the passing of every Bill. Assembly, the question upon the final passage of any Bill shall be taken immediately upon its last reading, and the yeas and nays entered upon the journal.
