Mr. J. P. Macmaster's Island Home for Sick Children.

Over seven years ago a few philanthropic ladies, recognizing the urgent need of such an institution in this city, founded an hospital for the sick and maimed children.

The idea of extending their work by starting a branch on the island was proposed last year when plans were prepared for the construction of a building to cost \$4000.

There are not sufficient funds for the present, but the matter was laid over until this year.

A week or two ago Mrs. S. F. Macmaster, the leading spirit in this and other Christian enterprises, obtained from the city council a grant of land 2 1/2 acres in extent on the southwest corner of the island.

This lot is most pleasantly situated in the city, and the thousand dollars and sloping gently westward facing the setting sun.

The advantage of such a spot for a convalescent home is obvious. It affords at once a place where the little invalids can enjoy the delicious summer air, cool and fresh from the lake, which they have easy access to.

It is proposed that the building be situated in a suitable manner by the different Sunday schools of the city.

It is expected that other schools will aid in proportion to the number of children on the city will take an interest in the support of the home, which will be thrown open to them and all other visitors every afternoon.

The place is intended to accommodate twenty-five children, the ages being limited to from 2 to 14 years. It will not only be for the benefit of Toronto children, but is accessible to all from the country.
