Arzentino Republic line issued a new series of stamms. The steel engraving represents the republic sitting, the right erm resting on the national shield, with the River de la Plate and a rising sun, as a background; above is the inscription "Republica Argentina" And paper of these stamps has on the back a sun as witer mark. The values of these stamps ara j. 1, 2, 5, 10, 12, 16, 20, 24, 30 and 50 centavos; they are printed in one colour each, and bear in the loner corners the value in figure and in the mildle the word 'centaves' The stamps of 1, 5, 10 and 20 person are targer and printed in two colours. They have the value in the left upper conner in theorem and in letters at the lase.

The counts are: I contave, bisters teentave green; 2 centave, finling; 5 centave, cormine; 10 centave, dark-green; 12 centave asky blue; 10 centave, dark-green; 12 centave, asky centave, 24 centave, violet, 30 centave, contave, Priessan blue; 1 pece, green and Plack, 5 pece, orange and black, 10 pece, green and black, 20 jeste, carmine and black.

The rate of postage will be the same as to any part of the United States, and this being the size, there is no reason why a distinction should be made between the Island and any other American territory.
